His initials were so weather worn that they were not readable. 41 years old. Oldest grave in the Young Cemetery.

Hilda wife of J. H. Moore

Born July 31, 1882

Died: August 12, 1905

23 years old. It is believed she was a Young and married Mr. Moore. Moore was her married name.

There are only four graves located in the Young's Cemetery. The Cemetery is surrounded by a white iron fence. (There didn't appear to be any unmarked graves in this small cemetery.)

The Young Cemetery is located on Riverside Drive, second division of 777 Estates. This land is owned by Margie Sue and J. E. (Gene) Carlisle. All of their three plots of land runs from the Riverside Drive down to the banks of the Lampasas River which runs South toward I-35 and/or Salado, Texas.
