On the first day of January 1877, I promise to pay at Lewisburg West Virginia to the order of Mason Matthews and Samuel Price, executors of the will of Henry Erskine dec<sup>d</sup>. the sum of two thousand two hundred and ninety nine + <sup>50</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars with interest from the first day of January 1873 until maturity at the rate of six per cent per annum, and if not punctually paid at the rate of eight per cent per annum from maturity until paid, this being the fourth installment of the purchase money for the league, in the Jose de la Baum Six-league survey, belonging to the Estate of Henry Erskine dec<sup>d</sup>.
