On the first day of January 1876, I promise to pay at Lewisburg West Virginia, to the order of Messrs Mathews and Samuel Price Executors of the Will of Henry Erskine dec^d, the sum of two thousand two hundred and a ninety nine $\frac{50}{100}$ dollars with interest. From the first day of January 1873 until maturity at the rate of six per cent per annum, and if not punctually paid, at the rate of Eight per cent per ~~annum~~ from maturity until paid, this being the third installment of the purchase money ^{for} the league, in the Jose de la Baum six-league survey, belonging to the Estate of Henry Erskine dec^d.
