wise engaged may I have

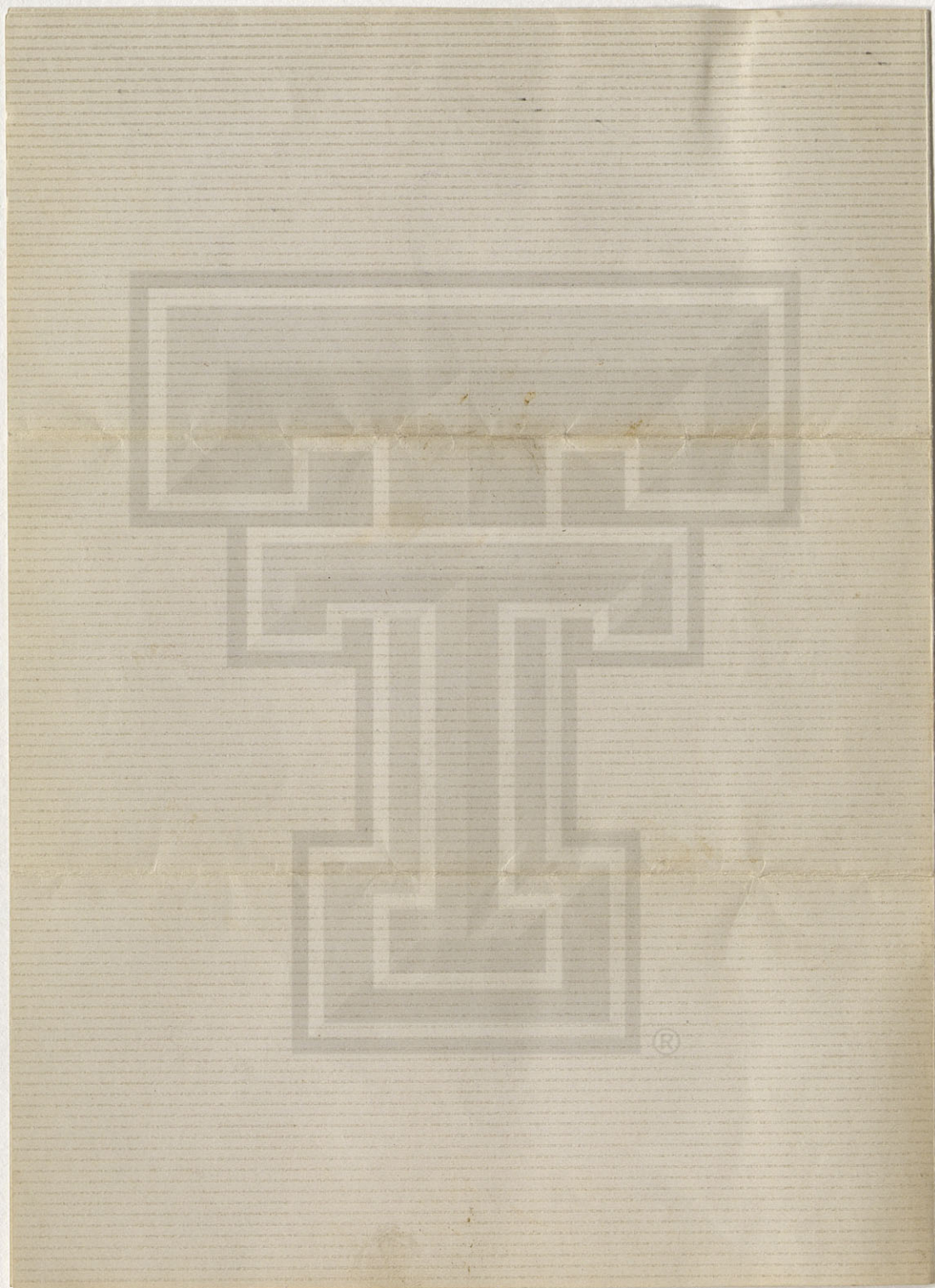
