

SADDLES

ADDLES are not luxuries, but necessities. From the earliest times man has been a rider. But no nation or people is so skilled in feats of horsemanship as are the Western stockmen or cowboys. They are a distinctive class, possessing the courage, skill, and fidelity which always characterize the noblest and the best of men. In their difficult range work they require the very best equipment, as not only the heavy ranch work, but ofttimes the safety of their very lives is dependent upon it. Hence the necessity of having the best, and our saddles are made strictly to meet these needs.

LADIES' ASTRIDE SADDLES have been our specialty for many years. In their construction, the same general principles are adhered to as in the making of the best stock saddles. For, if a lady is going to ride astride, and according to our way of thinking this is the only way for her to ride, she certainly is entitled to all the advantages of the very best stock saddle.

BUCK-SKIN INLAID SEATS: The demand for this special style of seat is ever on the increase, and by the best riders. We not only use it on astride saddles, but on many of the highest grade stock saddles. The seat is inlaid on the other seat in such a way that, in case it should wear out in the course of time, a good seat would still be maintained in the saddle. It is especially adapted to the "Myres' Special Tree." This seat will be used on any saddle, not showing the same, or we can put this seat on an old saddle. The prices range from \$9.00 to \$12.00 additional.

STYLE OF RIGGING: We generally make all saddles with double rig, but will change any style, and will use Center Fire, Three-Quarter, or Spanish.

TREES

The tree is the important part of any saddle. With everything else good, but with a bad tree, the inevitable result is a poor saddle—one that will give trouble and be unsatisfactory.

Our trees are specially made for us by the most skilled experts, men who have spent a lifetime in studying the rider's wants. The very latest style and designs are used. We keep strictly up-to-date on everything; in fact, lead the procession. Our trees come as near meeting all the requirements of the riders as is possible until all riders ride alike and all horses' backs are shaped alike.

Our trees are regularly made for medium size horses. If ponies or large horses are used, a narrower or wider tree should be made, accordingly. The trees are guaranteed against breakage for a period of two years. Should any of the trees hurt, we will gladly fix the same free of charge, when it is the fault of the tree. Several things could cause the saddle to hurt other than the tree:

First. Bad blankets, or carelessness in blanketing, often causing a wrinkle or fold in the blanket; but especially the continued use of wet, sweaty blankets

for days without having them washed or cleaned. This causes the back to become soft and tender. This is notably true in the hot months. Give good attention to the blankets, and many troubles will disappear.

Second. Sometimes the hurting is due to the peculiar condition or shape of the horse's back. This is especially true if the horse is thin or in poor condition.

The d any Third. Possibly that which causes as much or more hurting than all other things taken together is the way one rides. Some riders never hurt with any saddle, while others hurt with every saddle. We have given this trouble special attention, and shaped the saddle seats to throw one as nearly as possible in the proper position in the saddle and thus overcome the condition brought about by loose or careless riding.

THE FOLLOWING TREES ARE USED: Visalia, Broncho Buster, Rough Riders, Caudle, Ladesma, Tipton, Jim Dandy, Bull Moose, Citizen, Western Queen Astride, Youth's and Myres' Special.

The favor in which the Myres' Special Tree has been received by the best riders is truly gratifying. The attractive feature of the saddle is the specially low cantle.

Sterling, Brass, or Bell Medal horns will be used on any saddle not showing the same when desired, but for heavy work we recommend the regular iron horn tree, covered with leather or rawhide, as we consider it stronger than either the brass or the bell medal. When brass, bell medal, or sterling horns are wanted, add \$3.00 to catalogue price.

THE EXTRA SWELL FORK will be used on any saddle, not showing the same, at the following prices: 12-inch fork being taken as a base, add \$1.50 an inch up to 16 inches. On all swells over 16 inches, add \$2.50 for each additional inch.

For saddles with larger trees than described in catalog, add \$4.50 per inch for each additional inch for additional cost of material.

MATERIAL

All leather used in the construction of our saddles is from the famous Eberhard Tanning Company, of Santa Clara, California, who produce the finest skirting leather in the world. We also use their bark-tanned wool skins, chaps and lace leather, which are without an equal.

WORKMANSHIP

The manufacturing department is under the personal supervision of S. D. Myres. You may be sure that none but skilled mechanics touch your saddle

if it bears the name "Myres." The same scrutinizing care and attention is given to every detail as you would if you were making it with your own hands.

Special notice is called to the fact, that all points on high-grade saddles are hand-laced, which is much better than rivet work, inasmuch as rivets, after a time, will work loose and come out. Lacing never does. Tacks are practically discarded. Brass screws are used for all tree fastenings.

STAMPING

This department is under artists who, by nature and experience, have become past masters in this particular field. Many of the designs are original and entirely new. Nothing adds more to a high-grade piece of work than artistic finish, and this can be given only by one who is an artist in this special line of work. The favor with which our hand-carved saddles have been received for years by the very best riders is evidence of the quality and durability of our work. We call special attention to our art leather goods, which for mechanical finish and artistic design cannot be surpassed.

OILING

All saddles are carefully and skilfully oiled with Neatsfoot oil, unless otherwise ordered. Oil is the life of leather.

TERMS

All saddles in this catalogue are strictly net, no discount, as it has always been our policy to give in quality instead of in discount. Our prices are strictly cash; no credit.

In ordering, just give number as described in the catalogue. It is not necessary to destroy or mutilate the book in order to send picture.


