Went first to New Mexico - Was in the battle of Valverde - Was taken prisoner in hospital at Santa Fe. in March 1862. Was exchanged in Spring of 1863. And was in the Campaigns in La in 1863 and 1864. Was in battles of Piche, ^{near} Bernwick's bay, ~~Donaldsonville~~ and following engagements ^{in La} to Donaldsonville in 1863. And in battles of Mansfield - Pleasant Hill and engagements following to Yellow Bayou ^{in 1864}. Was wounded at Valverde Donaldsonville and Yellow Bayou. Was discharged in May 1865.
