



The name of TX Gold Star Medal recipient and TX CSA pensioner from Haskell County, TX(#22556) was JACOB HEMPHILL. He was a sergeant in Company H, 5th Texas Infantry, NVA. He was wounded four times at four different battles as following:

2nd Manassas on August 30, 1862

Antietam on September 17, 1862

Wilderness on May 6, 1864

White Oak Swamp on August 16, 1864

Was paroled at Appomattox on April 12, 1864.

Mentioned in Yeary's book, page 324. Home: Haskell, Texas.

Head Portrait of Sergeant Hemphill in Simpson's book, *HOOD'S TEXAS BRIGADE*, page 522.

He is buried in North Belton Cemetery, lot 542, 5 FEB 1844 - 14 FEB 1935. I locate the grave by information provided by his 2nd Great Grandson. He moved from Haskell after his wife died to live with a daughter in Belton..

Another man you all should be aware of who's also in the Belton North cemetery is John Patterson Osterhout.
