AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 1:30 o'clock p.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 171 Present, 6 Absent-excused, 4 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

Reverend Harold G. Zink, Rector, St. Mary's Cathedral, Austin, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

O Almighty Father, we humbly ask You for guidance in the deliberations with which we are faced, so that our decisions may be wise and just after the manner of Your wisdom and guidance. We pray that with the power with which You have endowed us, that where there is unrest, we may spread contentment; that where there is wrong, we may set things aright; that where there is discord, we may create harmony; that where there is error, we may uproot it to sow trust; that where there is despair, we may replace it with hope; that where there is ignorance, we may instill knowledge and further education; that where there is poverty, we may help in some small way to ease the pangs of hunger and nakedness; that where there is inequality, we may be reminded of our own national legislation that all men are created equal, and help work more toward that equality; and that where there is darkness and the threat to remove life, we may shed light and bring life into the world to prepare our fellowman to live a better life here in preparation for the life to come in the next world—all of which we ask for in the Spirit. Amen.

Delegate Spurlock was granted leave of absence for today on account of illness on motion of Delegate Willis.

Delegate Howard was granted leave of absence for today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Uher.

ARTICLE VII ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article VII.

Question: Shall Article VII be adopted?

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Clark was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of illness on motion of Delegate Green of Harris.

The President laid before the Convention Article VII, Section 6 (consideration having been postponed until 1:30 o'clock today).

Delegate Caldwell offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 6:

Amend Article VII, Section 6, to read as follows:

Sec. 6. SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICTS. The Legislature by general law shall provide for school districts and community junior college districts; and these districts may provide local enrichment of educational programs consistent with general law.

The amendment was read and was adopted by the following vote: 159 Yeas, 4 Nays, 18 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Craddick, Slack and Evans who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

The President laid before the Convention Article VII, Section 8.

Delegate Presnal explained Section 8.

Delegate Agnich offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII, Section 8, Subsection (c) between the words "fund." in the second sentence thereof and "In" the following language:

Stock is not eligible for purchase unless it is issued by a company incorporated in the United States which has paid dividends on its common stock, or whose predecessor companies have paid dividends on their common

stock, for at least five years preceding the date of purchase and, except for stock issued by a bank or stock issued by an insurance company with capital and surplus of not less than Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) and admitted assets of not less than Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000), is listed on an exchange registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission or its successors.

The amendment was read and was adopted by the following vote: 129 Yeas, 36 Nays, 16 Not Voting. (Record 3, Appendix)

Delegate Washington offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII, Section 8 (d) to read as follows:

(d) The net income (that is, dividends, interest, and other income less administrative expense) of the Permanent University Fund, exclusive of net income attributable to grazing leases of Permanent University Fund land, shall constitute the Available University Fund. Out of one-third of the Available University Fund, the Legislature shall appropriate an annual sum sufficient to pay the principal and interest due on Permanent University Fund bonds or notes issued by the Board of Directors of the Texas A&M University System pursuant to the next section or its predecessor sections of prior constitutions, and the remainder of such one-third of the Available University Fund shall be appropriated by the Legislature for the support and maintenance of Texas A&M University at College Station, Prairie View A&M University and Tarleton State University, each institution's share to be prorated on the basis of its scholastic enrollment. Out of the other two-thirds of the Available University Fund, the Legislature shall appropriate an annual sum sufficient to pay the principal and interest due on Permanent University Fund bonds or notes issued by the Board of Regents of The University of Texas System pursuant to the next section or its predecessor sections of prior constitutions, and the remainder of such two-thirds of the Available University Fund, plus the net income (that is, income less administrative expense) from grazing leases of Permanent University Fund land, shall be appropriated by the Legislature for the support and maintenance of The University of Texas at Austin.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Presnal moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 97 Yeas, 65 Nays, 19 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Wolff who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Delegate Mattox offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII, Section 8, Subsection (d) as follows:

(1) Between "County of Brazos" and the period, insert "and for support of recruitment and financial aid for residents of this State who attend an institution included in The Texas A&M University System".

(2) Between "Austin" and the period, insert "and for recruitment and financial aid programs for residents of this State who attend an institution included in The University of Texas System".

(Delegate Snelson in the Chair)

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Vick was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Boone.

Delegate Presnal moved to table the amendment.

(President in the Chair)

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 103 Yeas, 62 Nays, 16 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

REASON FOR VOTE

It was my intention to vote "No" on tabling the Mattox-Vale amendment but was shown as voting "Aye". The reason for the incorrect vote being cast was that following the repair of my desk voting machine, after the 4th Record Vote, the plastic covers were reversed (Green indicating "No" and Red "Aye").

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Mauzy (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Schwartz (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Williamson offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII by striking Subsections (b), (c), and (d) of Section 8 and substituting the following:

(b) The Permanent University Fund shall be held in trust for the people of Texas and the income from the fund shall be used to furnish each individual an equal educational opportunity at the college level. In pursuance of such trust, the Board of Regents or other trustees as designated by law shall have the authority to sell, lease, exchange, and otherwise manage the assets of the fund as provided by law. The income from the Permanent University Fund shall be distributed to the public institutions of higher education in the State according to their scholastic population by an agency designated by law.

(c) The Board of Regents or other trustees designated by law may invest the Permanent University Fund in securities, bonds, or other obligations issued, insured, or guaranteed in any manner by the United States government, or any of its agencies, in bonds issued by the State of Texas or any political subdivision thereof, and in such bonds, debentures, obligations, preferred stocks, or common stocks issued by corporations, associations, or other institutions as the Board of Regents or other trustees may deem to be proper investments for the Permanent University Fund. However, not more than one percent of the fund shall be invested in the securities of any one corporation nor shall more than five percent of the voting stock of any one corporation be owned by the fund. In making each and all investments, the Board of Regents or other trustees shall exercise the judgment and care under the circumstances then prevailing that men of ordinary prudence, discretion, and intelligence exercise in the management of their own affairs, not in regard to speculation, but in regard to the permanent disposition of their funds, considering the probable income therefrom as well as the probable safety of their capital. The Board of Regents or other trustees shall make full disclosure of all investments as provided by law.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Foreman moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 123 Yeas, 43 Nays, 15 Not Voting. (Record 6, Appendix)

Delegate Wallace (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Creighton (absent), who would vote "Yea".

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Lee who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Delegate Denton offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII, Section 8, by striking Sections (b), (c), and (d) thereof and substituting the following:

(b) The Permanent University Fund shall be held in trust for the people of Texas and for the use and benefit of educational institutions beyond the secondary level. The Fund shall be administered and invested as provided by law.

(c) The net income (that is, dividends, interest, and other income less administrative expense) of the Permanent

University Fund, exclusive of net income attributable to grazing leases of Permanent University Fund land, shall constitute the Available University Fund. Out of the Available Fund the legislature shall appropriate an annual sum sufficient to pay the principal and interest due on Permanent University Fund bonds or notes issued pursuant to the next section or its predecessor sections of prior constitutions. The remainder of the Available Fund, plus the net income (that is, income less administrative expense) from grazing leases of Permanent University Fund land, shall be appropriated by the legislature for the support and furtherance of educational institutions beyond the secondary level.

The amendment was read.

(Delegate Doran in the Chair)

Delegate Snelson moved to table the amendment.

(President in the Chair)

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 129 Yeas, 38 Nays, 14 Not Voting. (Record 7, Appendix)

Delegate Wallace (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Creighton (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Mauzy (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Schwartz (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Vecchio offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII, Section 8, Subsection (c), sentence 1 by adding after the word "invest" the following language:

With the approval of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives and the Senate Finance committee sitting as a joint committee.

Delegate Presnal moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 132 Yeas, 32 Nays, 17 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

The Legislature shall appropriate not less than one million dollars each fiscal year, from the Available University Fund allocated to Texas A&M University, for the support and maintenance of Prairie View A&M University and Tarleton State University.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 125 Yeas, 41 Nays, 15 Not Voting. (Record 9, Appendix)

Delegate Wallace (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Creighton (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Hall of Harris offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII, Section 8(d) by striking "County of Brazos" and adding in its place the word "System".

Delegate Presnal moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 86 Yeas, 75 Nays, 20 Not Voting. (Record 10, Appendix)

Delegate Wallace (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Creighton (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Mauzy (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Schwartz (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Washington offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII, Section 8(d) as follows:

(1) After the words "Texas A&M University" add the word "System". Delete the words "in the County of Brazos".

(2) After the words "the University of Texas" add the word "System". Delete the words "at Austin".

The amendment was read.

Delegate Presnal moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 78 Yeas, 86 Nays, 17 Not Voting. (Record 11, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Mauzy (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Schwartz (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment, shall the amendment be adopted?

The amendment failed of adoption by the following vote: 82 Yeas, 82 Nays, 17 Not Voting. (Record 12, Appendix)

Delegate Washington requested a verification of Record 12. The verification was ordered and reflected the following vote: 82 Yeas, 82 Nays.

Accordingly, the amendment failed of adoption.

Delegate Reynolds offered the following amendment to Article VII, Section 8:

Amend Article VII by striking Section 8 and substituting the following:

Sec. 8. PERMANENT UNIVERSITY FUND. The permanent university fund consists of two million acres of land set aside for the support of the University of Texas System and the Texas A&M University System, the proceeds from the sale of the land, and the securities and assets purchased with the proceeds. The permanent university fund shall be administered as provided by law. Other than the sale of oil, gas, and other minerals the land set apart may not be sold, exchanged or otherwise disposed of in any manner without the record vote of two-thirds of the membership of each house. Only the income from the permanent university fund may be appropriated and expended in support of the University of Texas System and the Texas A&M University System.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Snelson moved to table the amendment.
