


Dear Sir:

This letter goes to you in a spirit of friendliness, of frankness and sincerity, with the conviction that you will receive it in the same spirit and read it with an open mind.


Your letter received yesterday and was surely surprised to hear from you.







I just noticed a clipping which I am enclosing from the Texarkana Paper in regard to the Santafee extending its line into Lovington.



Thank you for your letter of August 20.

There is evidently some confusion in the size that you mentioned. There is no such size tire as 28x4.75-18 and you evidently have 28x4.75-19 tires.

Our best tube in this size is \$2.15 and four would be \$8.60. The Blow-out Proof tire in this size is a six ply tire but it is not built with the Silent Safety tread but with the Dual Grip tread. These tires are \$12.50 each, or four would be \$50.00. The four ply General tire in this size is \$7.44.

We can assure you that all of our stock is fresh merchandise, as we do not carry an extremely large stock but receive shipments every day or two.

If you are going to be in Wichita Falls at any time in the future we would appreciate an opportunity to show you these tires and tubes.







We appreciate your letter and sketch but we do not furnish blue prints or plans for plumbing or housing service. We have added to your sketch, which we are returning, to show the location of fixtures you probably will find most convenient. From the standpoint of material and labor economy, however, it would be better to locate the closet where the lavatory is shown and the lavatory nearer the door on the same side of the wall.

Our 4" vitrified sewer tile is 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ cents a foot and fittings to fit are 65 cents each. A septic tank circular is enclosed to show how this part of your system should be installed. Farm drainage tile is 10 cents a foot. A 4" stack with fittings will cost about \$16.00, and a built-in shower unit may be purchased at the prices in our catalog.

Call for your order if you like, but we suggest sending it in several days before you call to avoid a tedious wait. If a complete estimate is required more definite information must be sent. Use the prepaid envelope for placing your order with us.



It is the action of the bacteria in the septic tank, together with the nitrification or aeration process which goes on in the tile disposal bed which purifies the sewage and destroys the germs. It is the same process as used in the most expensive sewage disposal plants installed by large municipalities throughout the country. The practicability and proven effectiveness of this process is unquestionable. **In operation our Hercules Septic Tank is absolutely odorless.**

The raw sewage as it comes into the septic tank contains considerable animal and vegetable solids which must first be broken up and oxidized so as not to be offensive or dangerous. There are thus two separate operations to be provided for if the sewage is properly purified. Both of these processes are carried on through the action of microscopic vegetable bodies known as bacteria. Certain bacteria called anaerobes, because they can thrive and work only when protected from the air, have the power to change animal and vegetable solids to liquids and gases. Other bacteria called aerobes, because they can thrive only when kept in contact with air, have the power to purify the liquids produced by the anaerobes by oxidizing them and changing them to pure water and gases.



Easy to Install


Hercules Septic Tanks are easy to install, no skilled labor being required, and after they are installed they require no further attention whatever. The Septic Tank may be located within 10 feet of the building, but should be at least 15 feet away from any well or spring. Top of tank should be at least 12 inches to 18 inches below surface of ground.

To complete the installation of any septic tank sewage disposal system, it is necessary to provide an Absorption Bed or a Dry Well for disposal of the fluid after it leaves the tank. We illustrate below several plans by which the overflow or clarified water from the septic tank may be distributed through four-inch porous farm drain tile. The absorption bed should be sufficiently large to provide for twenty-five feet of tile for each person in the household. The tile can be laid as shown in the diagrams. Butt open joints of tile end to end and cover tops of joints with tar paper pads or broken tile. The runs of tile should be at least four feet apart. Drain tile should be laid with a slight down grade from tank. Where the soil is hard and non-porous, provide 30 to 50 feet of tile per person, and a little gravel, crushed stone, or cinders, should be placed in the bottom of the trench before tile is laid, and also on top of the tile before filling in with dirt. The aerating process which takes place in the absorption bed supplies the nitrogen which is necessary for the final purification of the sewage. From here it soaks away into the soil as a clear, harmless liquid.


Where a dry well or leaching pool is used, wall it up with material which allows water to percolate through wall, such as dry brick work, with the bottom left open to the soil. Bottom of well should be at least six feet below inlet pipe and not less than four feet in diameter. Equip with cover and air vent.




Plan Number One: This scheme for laying the tile in the absorption bed provides best distribution of the effluent and assures proper aeration.



Plan Number Two: Where Plan Number One cannot be conveniently followed, this plan is offered as the next best arrangement.



Plan Number Three: For sewage connection between the house and tank use four-inch cast iron soil pipe. For connection between the septic tank and leaching pool, use porous drain tile laid over a bed of cinders or gravel. This plan should be used only where space is very limited.









Dear Mr. Slaughter:

Some work came up which prevents my coming to St Jo to look over your job, however I am figuring it from the information you gave me.

I am not including in my estimate any ditching, as that is an uncertain quantity due to the possibility of running into rock, and as you no doubt will have a laborer on the job, you can probably do the ditching cheaper than we could.

I am not figuring any clay tile for drainage lines, or septic tank work or material; we are however figuring 4" cast iron soil pipe from the bath room to the location of the septic tank, which distance you said was not over 30 feet. We are also including enough 2" Galvanized pipe to run from the sink to a point below the septic tank, to avoid running the sink water through tank.

Our estimate covers necessary drain pipe and water pipe for all roughing work under the house, to take care of a closet combination, built in tub, pedestal lavatory, kitchen sink, and hot water heater, and labor of installing said materials and setting the above named fixtures. The fixtures and water heater are to be furnished by you, together with all trimmings for same such as bibbs, faucets, traps, supply pipes, sink brackets, in other words all fixtures and parts above floor line to be furnished by you.

Our estimate covers lead drum trap for your tub, as this has to be made up to fit your job.

We have figured the cold water line from fixtures to outside of house only, as we dont remember your telling us how far your water supply system was from the house, so we will bring the cold water line just outside the foundation, and you can either make your own connection, or we will, at an extra charge.

Our estimate covers gas line from nearest opening, to the water heater, but no other gas work covered.


