<sup>1</sup>The Laz people are an ethnic minority who live primarily in extreme northeast Turkey in Rize and Trabzon provinces. They are usually stereotyped as being stupid or very naive, though in fact they are no different from others. When Lazes tell Laz anecdotes, they sometimes follow the stereotyped image, but they sometimes show the Laz as being clever rather than stupid.
