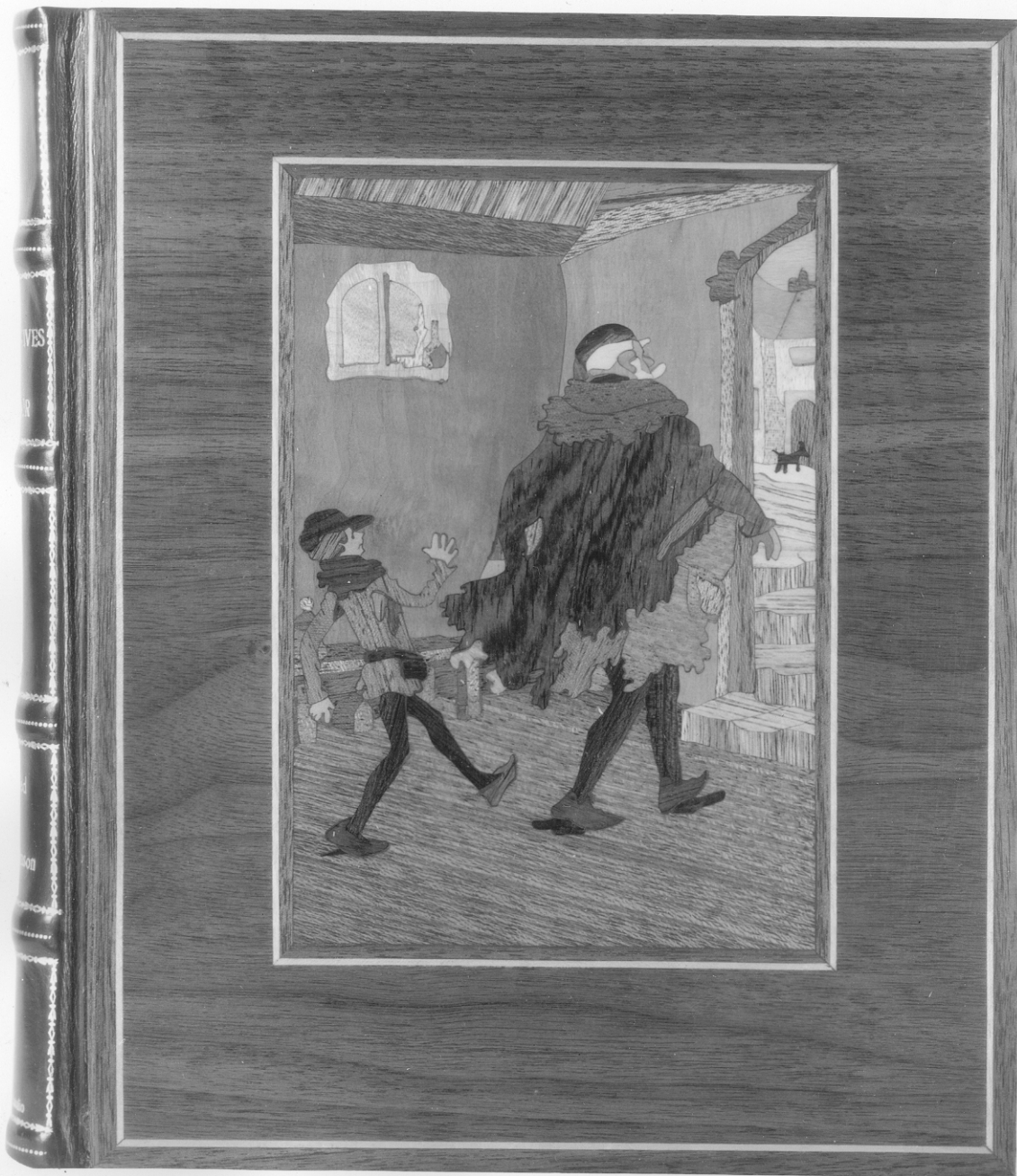




This Binding, the first ever made
