## **GOODEVILLE CEMETERY**

Located about one mile North of Schwertner, Texas on the old Bartlett/ Jarrell road. From IH 35, turn east at Jarrell on FM 487 for about 6 miles to Schwertner. In Schwertner at the point where FM 1106 (to Walburg) turns south (or intersects FM 487) turn left on a narrow black top road which is just east of the Bank, and go to the dead-end; turn left for about 200 yards. The small cemetery is about 50 yards in a field north of this gravelled road. From Bartlett Highway 95 go west on Clark Street to its end, then turn left on FM 487 to Schwertner, a-bout 5-6 miles, and proceed north pas the Bank as above.
