AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 9:00 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 155 Present, 10 Absent-excused, 16 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

Reverend Albert D. Moser, C.S.P., the Catholic Student Center at The University of Texas, Austin, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

Gracious Lord, thank you for a productive week. Slowly and painfully the work is being done. Bless this work; and bless those who are trying so hard to do it well.

Grant to these delegates satisfaction in accomplishment, and a restlessness to bring to completion a work of justice and truth. Amen.

LEAVES OF ABSENCE

Delegate Semos was granted leave of absence for today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Cates.

Delegate Adams of Jasper was granted leave of absence for today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Jones of Taylor.

Delegate Donaldson was granted leave of absence for today on account of illness in his family on motion of Delegate Kaster.

Delegate Newton was granted leave of absence for today on account of illness in his family on motion of Delegate Calhoun.

Delegate Blanchard was granted leave of absence for today on account of medical check-up on motion of Delegate Spurlock.

Delegate Hightower was granted leave of absence for today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Wallace.

ARTICLE VII ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article VII, Section 11.

Question: Shall the amendment as

amended be adopted?

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Hutchison was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Spurlock.

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Canales who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Delegate Preston moved to table the amendment as amended.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 80 Yeas, 65 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 35 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Hernandez, Sanchez, Sutton, Lee, Adams of Hardin, Washington, Gammage, Maloney, Whitmire, Rodriguez, Garcia and Ragsdale, who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

The President laid before the Convention Article VII, Section 2, the same having been previously postponed.

On motion of Delegate Barnhart and by unanimous consent, consideration of Section 2 was postponed until all pending amendments to other sections were disposed of.

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Hutchison who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

LEAVES OF ABSENCE

Delegate Cooke was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Coody.

Delegate Caldwell was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Kaster.

Delegate Atwell moved to reconsider the vote by which the Preston amendment to Article VII, Section 11, (see Journal page no. 490) failed of adoption. "Yeas" and "Nays" were demanded.

The motion to reconsider prevailed by the following vote: 79 Yeas, 77 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 24 Not Voting. (Record 3, Appendix)

Delegate Coody requested a verification of Record 3. The verification was ordered and reflected the following: 79 Yeas, 77 Nays.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Reynolds and Bales who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were

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announced "Present".

Question recurring on the adoption of the Preston amendment to Article VII, Section 11, "Yeas" and "Nays" were demanded.

The amendment was then adopted by the following vote: 82 Yeas, 78 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 20 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

Delegate Kaster requested a verification of Record 4.

Delegate McAlister moved to dispense with the verification.

Question on the motion to dispense with the verification.

The motion to dispense with the verification was lost by a non-record vote.

The verification was ordered and reflected the following: 82 Yeas, 78 Nays.

Delegate Powers moved to reconsider the vote by which the Snelson amendment to Article VII, Section 3, was adopted (see Journal page no. 395).

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Coody was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Braecklein.

Delegate Snelson moved to table the motion to reconsider.

Question on the motion to table, "Yeas" and "Nays" were demanded.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 86 Yeas, 76 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 18 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

LEAVES OF ABSENCE

Delegate Howard was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Craddick.

Delegate Hendricks was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Rodriguez.

Delegate McKinnon was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Hale.

Delegate Olson offered the following amendment to Article VII:

Amend Article VII, adding a new Section 11 to read as follows to wit:

Section 11. State Technical Education Assistance Fund. (a) There is hereby established the State Technical Education Assistance Fund to which is appropriated from

the state treasury each fiscal year an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the Available University Fund in the fiscal year in which this constitution is adopted. The legislature may increase this annual appropriation but may never decrease the same below the initial amount.

(b) Funds derived from the appropriation to the fund shall be allocated to state technical institutes. The allocation of funds to the several institutions shall be pursuant to equitable formulae, based on statewide technical educational needs, devised by the legislature or by an agency or department authorized by the legislature.

(c) The State Technical Education Assistance Fund may be used for the following purposes: (1) acquiring land either with or without permanent improvements; (2) constructing new buildings or other permanent improvements; (3) repairing and rehabilitating existing buildings or other permanent improvements; (4) acquiring library books and materials; (5) acquiring capital equipment; (6) paying the principal of and interest on any bonds issued pursuant to this authority; and (7) such other purposes as provided by law.

(d) There may be issued and refunded under this section bonds payable from an irrevocable lien and pledge of the monies on deposit in the State Technical Education Assistance Fund. These bonds may be issued for the respective institutions for any one or more of the said purposes set forth in (c) except (7). The total aggregate principal amount of such bonds which may be outstanding at any one time shall not exceed two and one half percent (2-1/2%) of the value of the Permanent University Fund, exclusive of real estate, at the time of any issuance. The legislature shall by law provide the procedures and limitations by and subject to which the bonds shall be issued and the manner in which their terms and details will be determined. Responsibility for the issuance of bonds shall be by the respective institutions as provided by law.

(e) This section shall not preclude the acquisition or construction of properties and facilities of the same type herein described by any lawful and Constitutional means by or for the institutions to which this Section applies.

(f) All bonds issued pursuant to this section shall be approved by the Attorney General of Texas and when so approved shall be incontestable.
