My Regiment was first in Cleburne Brigade
he being promoted to major general Stewart
was my next brigadier & then O H Strahl
was my next brigade commander & was under
Strahl until June the 22nd 1864 & on that
day I was captured by the enemy & taken
to camp Douglas Ill & remained there un-
til the close of the war taking the
oath on June the 16th 1865 & went home
as to my conduct as a soldier I refer
you to Capt J A Taylor Shelbyville Tenn
& to Lieut B W Fair of Nashville
I was in the battles of Shiloh Perryville
Murfreesboro Chickamauga Missionary ridge
Resaca & from Resaca up to my capture I
was fighting nearly every day
