The No. 3-A Saddle is made on Miles City tree, with ornaments of Sterling silver. It is excellently well balanced in design-not too large nor too small. Front and cantle binding, and binding on horn, are in heavy rope roll effect. Swell caps are made in thick silver and permanently fastened with heavy silver headed nails. Back of cantle covered entirely with solid silver, with your brand or initials inscribed in gold. Leaf and flower design on edges of skirts, and large corners on fenders, are of very thick silver, featuring a filagree pattern which permits the leather to show through. All silver is artistically engraved and substantially made throughout. Fenders are lined with very fine leather and are cut as shown in illustration unless otherwise specified. Also made, if desired, with straight or turned stirrup leathers. If you prefer straight leathers and wish to have them "broken in," we will gladly do so.

The No. 3-A Saddle can be had in black leather or tan with black inlay in carving, or all tan. The carving is the finest throughout. Your brand, or any special design you wish to have

executed, will be expertly carved. Rigging can be furnished in either flat leather style, flat bronze ring, or ordinary ring. Also, you have choice of single or double rig without additional cost. ### No. 1-A Saddle

(Illustrated on opposite page)

The No. 1-A Saddle is one of the leaders of the Bohlin line of quality saddles, and as such it is without duplication in the saddle-making business. This saddle, as illustrated on the opposite page, is made on the Miles City Tree, and is beautifully hand-carved on black leather. It can also be made in tan, or black and tan, with any style rigging preferred. The rigging shown in the accompanying picture is three-quarters style with flat leather rig, and the front and cantle binding is made from heavy sterling silver in rope roll design. The horn, with flower ornament on top, has the same binding.

Swell caps are fashioned from extra heavy silver to prevent denting, and are also overlaid with gold in scroll and flower design. The leaves have a raised vein of silver in the center and all the tie conchas are made from the same metal with a beautiful rope roll background, as illustrated in Ornament No. 99 on page 45.

The hucking horse and steer designs on the corners are raised in half figures, and are hammered out entirely by hand. To obtain this striking effect requires an enormous amount of time and exceptional skill.

### Silver Liberally Used

The corners are backed with silver, running under the leather an inch and a half. The edges throughout the saddle are covered entirely with silver rope roll, made in one-inch sections, to allow the leather to bend. These sections are attached to the leather by strong silver-headed rivets. The back of the cantle board is mounted in Indian and Teepe design with distant hills all done in gold of three shades.

The No. 1-A Saddle is made of the highest quality leather obtainable, and although mounted with silver and gold, it is so constructed as to be surprisingly light in weight.
















### No. 2-A Saddle

(Illustrated on opposite page)

The No. 2-A Saddle is outstandingly the finest saddle made. Matchless beauty, incomparable workmanship, and the finest quality materials, combine to give this saddle the highest possible rating known to the saddle world. It is the very acme of achievement in precious metal on leather. Some conception of the painstaking care required in making the No. 2-A saddle may be gained from the fact that six weeks are required from the time work is first started until it is completely finished.

This saddle is made with heavy Sterling silver front and cantle rope roll, as in the No. 1-A saddle. The horn has rope roll binding with flower design on top, and is wrapped entirely with one piece of silver. Swells are covered with silver caps, are mounted with flower ornaments, and are filigreed. The rigging shown in the illustration is three-quarters style, with flat leather. The corners have rope roll edges, extending underneath the leather; also filigreed design with raised steer heads in three shades of gold. Leaves have a raised vein of solid gold, as also have the buds in the center of the flowers.

### The Acme of Workmanship

The conchas are made like No. 99, as shown on page 45. The stirrups are mounted with a silver plate and filigreed flowers. The back of the saddle has a solid plate of silver, with initials and steer heads in three shades of gold, and is filigreed in a most intricate design.

This saddle can be made to your own design of fender and stirrup leathers. Also it can be made with tan leather and black inlay in the carving.

Execution of the design of this saddle is of a most tedious and intricate nature, as all the filigree work must be done by hand. The large pieces, such as the swell caps, for instance, are very hard to handle while in process of filigreeing, but the highly skilled workmanship that characterizes all Bohlin products is especially emphasized when the requirements are the most exacting. The exceptional beauty of the No. 2-A saddle, as well as its practicability, testify to the high standard of Bohlin craftsmanship.

#### To my Friends and Customers:

Fifty years ago the writer left the ranch to learn the Western saddle making trade. After four years work as an apprentice in the best known saddle shop of the West, he drifted westward and into the range country, where he made saddles for the REAL Cowboy and Western riders; and there formed the association of the GREAT characters of the West, some of whom have become national immortals. He touched elbows with and knew the pioneers, the buffalo hunters, the ranchmen and the cowboys—all sons of the plains. These men were his customers and his friends—all great hearted characters, and what an opportunity has been his to have such men as friends and to have learned their slant on life, the way they viewed things, and the way they did things. From these great men we learned much and especially about the requirements of the riders, and with the mechanical knowledge gathered by years of training, we have applied the things learned from THOSE WHO KNOW.

The catalogue which we send to you shows some of the things in saddles which were developed under the conditions mentioned—the knowledge derived from our years of experience is now given to you for inspection. What we have done speaks for itself—we leave it to you to judge.

When we can serve you, it will always give us pleasure. May the best always be yours. BE HAPPY—RIDE A MYRES SADDLE.



The tree is the important part of any saddle. With everything else good, but with a bad tree, the inevitable result is a poor saddle—one that will give trouble and be unsatisfactory.

Our trees are specially made for us by the most skilled experts, men who have spent a lifetime in studying the rider's wants. The very latest styles and designs are used. We keep strictly up-to-date on everything; in fact, lead the procession. Our trees come as near meeting all the requirements of the riders as is possible until all ride alike and all horses' backs are shaped alike.

Our trees are regularly made for medium sized horses. If ponies or large horses are used a narrower or wider tree should be made accordingly. The trees are guaranteed against breakage for a period of two years. Should any of the trees hurt, we will gladly fix the same free of charge, when it is the fault of the tree. Several things could cause the saddle to hurt other than the tree:

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FIRST. Bad blankets, or carelessness in blanketing, often causing a wrinkle or fold in the blanket; but especially the continued use of wet, sweaty blankets for days without having them washed or cleaned. This causes the back to become soft and tender. This is notably true in hot months. Give good attention to the blankets, and many troubles will disappear.

SECOND. Sometimes the hurting is due to the peculiar condition or shape of the horse's back. This is especially true if the horse is thin or in poor condition.

THIRD. Possibly what causes more trouble than any one thing is the manner in which one rides. Some riders never hurt with any saddle, while others hurt with every saddle. The skill of being able to properly balance in the saddle will go far to cure most of the hurts. So watch your balancing in the saddle and note the results. Our seats are shaped to assist in overcoming the condition brought about by loose or careless riding.

FOURTH. BE CAREFUL NOT TO PUT YOUR SADDLE ON THE HOT RADIATOR OF A CAR. We have seen the trees warped, the linings and the skirts burned out from this cause and the saddle made to hurt when otherwise it would not. Watch this and you will get around some other troubles.

Sterling, brass or bell metal horns will be used on any saddle not showing the same, when desired, but for heavy work we recommend the regular iron horn tree, covered with leather or rawhide, as we consider it stronger than either the brass or the bell metal. When brass, bell metal, or sterling horns are wanted, add \$3.00 to catalogue price.

The Extra Swell Fork will be used on any saddle, not showing the same, at the following prices: 12-inch fork being taken as a base, add \$1.50 an inch up to 16 inches. On all swells over 16 inches, add \$2.50 for each additional inch.

For saddles with larger trees than described in catalogue, add \$3.00 per inch for each additional inch for cost of material.

#### **Buckskin Seats**

This is something that we have specialized on for years and the favor with which these seats have been received by the actual riders, and the service which they have given, enables us, in the strongest manner, to recommend the same to you. These seats are inlaid on the regular leather seat in such a manner that in case they wear out or are not wanted, they can be removed at any time and a good seat would be maintained in the saddle. It is our experience that nine out of every ten who use this seat once will order the same again. This is conclusive proof of their efficiency and satisfaction. These seats will be used on any saddle not

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showing the same at from \$7.50 to \$10.00 extra, depending on the size and style of saddle.

#### Material

The leather which we use in our saddles is the very highest grade from the famous Eberhard Tanning Company at Santa Clara, California. These tanners have made our leather for the last forty years and the quality of their product is unequaled. We use not only their leather, but wool skins, chap leather and lace leather.

#### Workmanship

Three things are necessary in making any good saddle:-

First the *tree*, second the *material* and third the *workmanship*. Appreciating the importance of the workmanship, all of our mechanics have had years of training in our place and are familiar with all details and have the best practical knowledge of Western saddle making—only the BEST work for us.

It may not be amiss here to state that our saddles, except the cheaper, are all laced with buckskin laces, instead of being put together with rivets and where tree fastenings are necessary, we use screws instead of tacks or nails and the superiority of our workmanship is one of the *marked features* of our saddles. Examine our saddles and you will find their supremacy.

#### Stamping

Stamping is an art and it comes down to us from the earliest times. History advises us that the old Moors who over-ran Spain left traces of their handicraft in that country. The Spaniards carried it to Mexico and we got the same from that country. Hand-carving in the hands of an artist on the *right kind of leather* will increase the wearing power of the leather at least 50%. We speak from forty years of experience and observation when we make this statement; hence we can recommend the hand-carved work in the strongest way, as a wearing element to say nothing of the beauty which it adds to the finished product.

Please note our leather products and their high class. Our carvers are past masters in the art and our designs are new, distinctive and original; hence the supremacy of our work.

#### Oiling

All saddles are carefully and skilfully oiled with Neatsfoot oil, unless otherwise ordered. Oil is the life of leather.

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#### Terms

All saddles in this catalogue are strictly net, no discount, as it has always been our policy to give in quality instead of discount. Our prices are strictly cash; no credit.

In ordering, just give number as described in the catalogue. It is not necessary to destroy or mutilate the book in order to send picture.

Write your name, postoffice, and State plainly; also give your nearest express office.

All orders will have strict and careful attention, and will be filled as promptly as possible.

Special orders will have our best attention, and we will make you exactly what you order.






