I was never in any Regular Battles or engagements - our Cavalry - operated principally upon the western Border of Va along the Potomac River - we were almost-continuously Picket Fighting - & Skirmishing with the enemy - we lost our first commander - Col Dick Ashby whose horse became entangled in a cattle Bridge on the Baltimore & Ohio - R. R. where he was killed before he could extricate himself

I Recd - during the War Two Balls ^{through} The Body - one through the Leg & one in the Bottom of the Left foot - My first wound was Received - two days before Gen. Ashby was killed - on our Retreat up the Shenandoah Valley - to the Cross Keys fight where we defeated the combined forces of Banks Foremont & Shields - the three shots were Recd - in Frederick City Md - on our advance to the Gettysburg fight - our Cavalry ^{gave} ^{prisoners} ^{to} the advance of that Portion of infantry that dropped the Potomac at Shepherdstown Va
