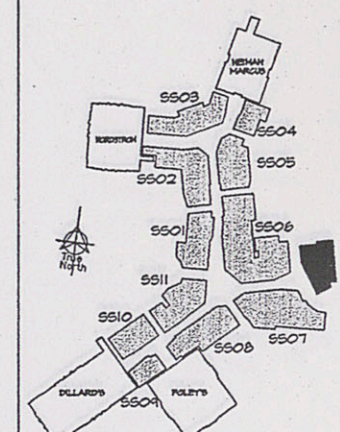
LANDSCAPE NOTES

- UNLESS SPECIFICALLY NOTED, INSTALL ALL PLANTED PLANTING UTILIZING EQUILATERAL TRIANGULAR SPACING.
- EVENLY APPLY 3" OF MULCH TO ALL CONTINUOUS PLANTING BEDS. TREES OCCURRING IN TURF AREAS SHOULD BE MULCHED WITHIN THE SOIL SAUCERS.
- FORM 3" DEEP EARTHEN SAUCERS AROUND ALL TREES. DO NOT INSTALL OTHER VEGETATION WITHIN THE SAUCER OF ANOTHER.
- SUBSTITUTIONS OF PLANT SPECIES, SIZES, OR OTHER SPECIFIED MATERIALS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT.
- PLANT MATERIAL AND LAYOUT MUST BE APPROVED BY LLA PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.
- ALL IDENTIFICATION TAGS PROVIDED BY GROWERS AND PLACED ON TREES AND SHRUBS ARE TO REMAIN ON THE PLANTS THROUGH THE PLANTING INSPECTION. TAGS ARE TO BE REMOVED PRIOR TO FINAL ACCEPTANCE, OR UPON REQUEST OF LLA.
- ALL SEEDING OF LAWN AREAS IS TO BE COMPLETED AS A PART OF THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACT. A MINIMUM OF 4" OF APPROVED TOPSOIL IS TO BE PROVIDED FOR ALL SOIL AND SEED AREAS.
- TOPSOIL AND SEEDING ARE TO BE APPLIED TO ALL LANDSCAPE WORK-DAMAGED GROUND SURFACES NOT OTHERWISE PLANTED OR SOILED.
- SUBCONTRACTOR SHALL REVIEW RELATED CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS FOR LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION AND SHALL ALSO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR COORDINATING WITH OTHER SITE CONTRACTORS TO DETERMINE ACTUAL AREAS OF SEEDING REQUIRED, INCLUDING AREAS DISTURBED BY UTILITY EXTENSIONS.
- SEE SPECIFICATIONS FOR APPROVED SOIL MIXTURES.
- TRANSPLANT OAKS AND ELMS ARE TO BE APPROVED PRIOR TO TRANSPLANTING. ANY REQUIRED STAKING FOR THESE TREES IS TO BE COORDINATED WITH LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT.
- DETAIL 5/ L3.0 DOES NOT APPLY TO 18" LIVE OAK. THIS TREE, DUE TO ITS LOCATION WILL HAVE BASALT GRAVEL UP TO TRUNK.
