Johnson Beauregard, Bragg Joseph E. Johnson Hood & last J. E. Johnson. I was in the battles of Shiloh Murfreesborough Chicamauga Perryville Murfreesville and other small battles in Ky. in all the battles of Johnsons Ga. campaign at Atlanta Jonesborough Franklin Nashville, in fact in every battle fought by the Gen Army except Missionary Ridge. Had not recovered from wounds received at Chicamauga I refer you to Stone wall Jackson Camp Brownwood Tex of which I was a member
