My Dear Sir

Your last letter from the Osage Station, (no date) informing us that you were to leave for Kansas City on Friday 13th but arrived in due course, you ask us to write you to Kansas but give no address, which is rather awkward and you also say that you are to leave for home on the 24th.

It appears to me that you had not got my letter of instructions regarding your consultation with Co. Fountain, but I hope you have since then received it, and have made arrangements to go to Las Cruces to see him, as there is no time to be lost, if our friend were to get any idea of our

movements, he might anticipate us, and raise money on the cattle himself, what I want is to anticipate him, and get hold of all the property in my name, which I suppose I can do altho not an American Citizen, ask Fountain about this, I can then transfer it to you or any one else, and I suppose I can take possession or prevent ~~the~~ any sales being made except in my name and on my behalf, ascertain if I can do so, and what steps I should take to prevent him interfering, you must be particular in regard to all this, and specially to give me all X Control over the assets -

The intimation of the dissolution to the Bank and all the Correspondents of the Forin cannot be done till after the 30th June, but the notice of dissolution to B - and the intimation

(if all in order), should be done
simultaneously, you will therefore
be guided by Fountain's instructions
as to this, and get him to draft
and advertisement & notice to you

I will have the Balance
sheet ready as soon as possible,
and you must keep the matter
quiet till we have all prepared.

It is perhaps so far lucky
that the weather has been un-
favorable, as there is no chance
now of having the Herd gathered
before the middle of July, by
that time I hope it will be
beyond his power to interfere,

Advise me what money
you send to Santa Fe, and what
arrangement you have made about
the Pasture, and the next payment
of \$1500. also when the other payments
are due.
