About 1839-40. George Hampton was appointed Land Agent for the Territory of Iowa by the President.

- (3) William Hampton, Esq. 3rd Son of Wm & Malinda Hampton, born in 1808 in Cabell Co. Pa. died at his home near Catlettsburg, Boyd Co. Ky. July 25, 1887. He owned large tracts of land in this part of Kentucky and the towns of Catlettsburg & Hampton City are built on parts of his home farm. His fine old brick residence is now in the edge of the latter town. He was an ardent Methodist; and in 1848, received a license from Bishops, as a local preacher, in the Southern Methodist Episcopal Church.

Aug 31, 1828 Wm Hampton was married to Sarah Buchanan, daughter of ~~Wm~~ Elizabeth Calwell Buchanan. Her father, Wm Buchanan, a ~~cousin~~ cousin of President Buchanan was born at Lancaster, Pa. and died in Lawrence Co Kentucky at the age of 92 years. About 1800 he removed from Pa. to Woodford Co. Ky. then a few years later to near Mt. Sterling, Montgomery Co. Ky. & still later to Lawrence Co. Ky. where he owned a farm of nearly a thousand ⁷⁰⁰ acres on the Big Sandy River. Buchanan Chapel & Buchanan P.O. in this County are named for him.

Said to have been born in Montgomery Co. Ky. at the home of his grandfather Shortridge.
