We remained at Beaufort Ga till Shermans March to the sea in December 1864 when we were driven out of this position and had a light battery with us till we had to give up at Green Pond S.C. on account of want of horses to pull the battery - We then went to Charleston S.C. and were on provost duty in Charleston about six weeks and then joined the 2nd Ga. Battalion infantry & were in the battles of Averyton and the battle of Bentonville N.C. where we surrendered with Johnston on 26th April 1865 -
