We remained at Beulah Ga till Shermonds March to the sea in December 1864 when we were driven out of this position and had a light battery with us till we had to give up at Green Pond S. C. on account of want of horses to pull the battery - we then went to Charleston S. C. and were on provost duty in Charleston about six weeks and then joined the 2nd Ga. Battalion infantry & were in the battles of Avery's Cross and the battle of Bentonville N. C. ^{and} where we surrendered ^{at Greensboro} with Johnston on 26th April 1865 -
