The Convention met at 1:30 o'clock p.m., pursuant to adjournment, and was called to order by the President.

(Delegate Koriath in Chair)

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 155 Present, 14 Absent-excused, 12 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

Delegate Tarbox was granted leave of absence for today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Sherman of Tarrant.

Delegate Ragsdale was granted leave of absence for today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Reyes.

Delegate Craddick was granted leave of absence for today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Howard.

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE CONSTITUTIONAL
CONVENTION RESOLUTION 35 ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention the following:

C.S.C.C.R. 35, Appropriating funds for the operation of the Constitutional Convention.

The resolution was read.

Delegate Cole explained the resolution.

Delegate Preston raised the Point of Order that Delegate Cole's time had expired.

Delegates Adams of Jasper, Geiger and Heatly moved Delegate Cole's time be extended. The extension was granted.

Delegate Cole continued the explanation of the resolution.

Delegate Preston raised the Point of Order that Delegate Cole's time had expired. There were objections.

Delegate Heatly moved that Rule VIII, Section 7 be suspended in order to extend Delegate Cole's time. The motion prevailed by the following vote: 104 Yeas, 27 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 49 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

Delegate Cole continued the explanation of the resolution.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Doyle and Head who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Wyatt raised the Point of Order that Delegate Cole's time had expired. There were objections.

Delegate Heatly moved that Rule VIII, Section 7 be suspended in order to again extend Delegate Cole's time. The motion was lost by the following vote (not receiving two-thirds vote of the Members present): 89 Yeas, 55 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 36 Not Voting. (Record 3, Appendix)

Delegate Agnich offered the following amendment to C.S.C.C.R. 35:

Amend C.S.C.C.R. 35 by striking the words "and, be it further" at the end of the third Resolving Clause, and substituting the following:

"provided, however, that none of the

funds which are appropriated hereunder shall be expended for the promotion or advertising of, or for travel expenses incurred by Members of the Convention or their staffs in advocating, the adoption or rejection of the Constitution proposed by the Texas Constitutional Convention or any part thereof; and, be it further".

The amendment was read.

On motion of Delegate Agnich, and by unanimous consent, the amendment was withdrawn.

Delegate Wieting was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate McKinnon.

Delegate Rosson was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of compassionate reasons on motion of Delegate Short.

Delegate Lauhoff was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Jones of Harris.

Delegate Adams of Jasper offered the following amendment to C.S.C.C.R. 35:

Amend C.S.C.C.R. 35 by substituting the numbers "1,210,116" for the numbers "1,815,177" wherever they appear and the date "June 30, 1974" for the date "July 30, 1974" wherever it appears.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Cole moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 87 Yeas, 61 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 32 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

Delegate Snelson was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Aikin.

Delegate Gaston was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Reynolds.

Delegate Simmons offered the following amendment to C.S.C.C.R. 35:

Amend C.S.C.C.R. 35, line 12 by striking "July 30" and substituting in lieu thereof "July 3".

The amendment was read.

Delegate Coleman moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 89 Yeas, 50 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 40 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Jones of El Paso (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Ogg (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Delegate Agnich offered the following amendment to C.S.C.C.R. 35:

Amend C.S.C.C.P. 35 by striking the words "and, be it further" at the end of the third Resolving Clause, and substituting the following:

"provided, however, that none of the funds which are appropriated hereunder shall be expended for the promotion or advertising of, or for travel expenses incurred by Members of the Convention or their staffs in advocating, the adoption or rejection of the Constitution proposed by the Texas Constitutional Convention or any part thereof except that this provision shall not apply to a delegate's communications with constituents or a delegate's travel to, from, or within his district; and, be it further".

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Strike the \$40,500 Item F, Professional Services of Section IV in its entirety;

Strike the \$12,000 Item G, General Convention Support of Section IV in its entirety;

Correct the Total Budgeted figure to read \$1,722,677 and change the figure of \$1,815,177 on Page 1, line 6 to read \$1,722,677.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Cole moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 66 Yeas, 69 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 44 Not Voting. (Record 6, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Jones of El Paso (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Ogg (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment, the amendment failed of adoption by the following vote: 52 Yeas, 86 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 41 Not Voting. (Record 7, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Jones of El Paso (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Ogg (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Williamson offered the following amendment to C.S.C.C.R. 35:

Amend C.S.C.C.R. 35, Exhibit A by striking the following items and correcting all subtotals and totals accordingly:

IIC, IID, III, IVE1, IVE2, IVF, IVG.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Cole moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 96 Yeas, 39 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 44 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

Delegate Barnhart offered the following amendment to C.S.C.C.R. 35:

Amend C.S.C.C.R. 35 by adding the following:

Resolved, That the payment of per diem expenses for Convention Delegates be stopped effective on adjournment or recess of the Convention on July 3, 1974.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Cole moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 82 Yeas, 55 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 42 Not Voting. (Record 9, Appendix)

Delegate Denton offered the following amendment to C.S.C.C.R. 35:

The amendment was read and failed of adoption by the following vote: 14 Yeas, 114 Nays, 5 Present-Not Voting, 48 Not Voting. (Record 10, Appendix)

Delegate Cole moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 101 Yeas, 44 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 34 Not Voting. (Record 12, Appendix)
