

Chattering Between Halves

The first warning on today's game is keep your eye on this Bill Brock of the Creighton Bluejays...he is a dangerous touchdown artist. In the Creighton and Washington game, Brock galloped 80 yards for a touchdown. In last week's game against the Oklahoma Aggies, Brock intercepted a pass on the Bluejay's 10-yard line and returned it 90 yards for a touchdown...if you can be in starting toward the Tech goal line today ... close your eyes and pray.

... the Bluejays have four of the nation's leading offensive rushers in Tony Porto, Tom Dineen, Bob Fitzgearld and Bill Brock.

This Bill Brock of the Jays is a brother of All-American Center Charlie Brock, one-time University of Nebraska great, now with the Green Bay Packers of the National Professional League.

... maybe it doesn't matter but George Washington Dunn, Creighton sophomore center, and Guard Carl Buda celebrate birthdays with the Father of their country... George Washington.

Just for your information the Creighton line will average 197 pound, and the backfield will average 174 pounds.

... the Army will come to the game this afternoon. John McGillicuddy, Creighton's giant left end, has a second-lieutenant's commission in the infantry reserve. Last June Lieut. McGillicuddy requested and was granted one year's deferment.

"Tiny Tim" Dinneen, Creighton's 150-pound halfback, carried the ball 16 times in the first two game and wound up with an average of eight yard per lug. Let us hope he is not so good against the Red Raiders.

... remember what a difficult time the Red Raiders had last year in beating the St. Louis Billikens, 7 to 6. Well, the same Billikens will come to Lubbock next Saturday for a return engagement with the Raiders. This should easily be one of the most interesting games on Tech's schedule. You fans will get to see one of the best triple-threat backs in the country in Dick Weber who made a number of All-American selections last season.

Since there was no scoring by the Red Raiders last week at Miami, Roger Smith, junior left halfback, continues to lead the Raiders scoring parade with three touchdowns, six conversions and one field goal for 27 points. Clarence Tillery, senior right end, is second with three touchdowns and one conversion for 19 points. Fleet-footed Don Austin, junior right halfback, is in third place with three touchdowns for 18 points, and J. R. Callahan, sophomore left halfback, is fourth with two touchdowns and three conversions for 15 points.
