Notes

The Geography of that portion of Country lying between the Arkansas and Canadian Rivers is laid down from information obtained from the Comanche and Kiowa Indians, and confirmed by Mr. Simpson.
The Santa Fe Road from the crossing at the Arkansas River and the Arkansas River, from Bent's Fort to the Pawnee Rock, are laid down as surveyed by Lieut. Franklin U.S.T.E.
The Streams north of the Arkansas, are represented as laid down by Captain J. C. Fremont, U.S.T.E.
The positions of Santa Fe and Taos are laid down from Mr. Gregg.
