He has round naked cars, long reddish hairs around the face, and brighty sellowish white hairs, nearly of an equal length on the rest of the body, with a considerable toff at the extremity of the tail. He walks upon four feet; and exceeds not eight or nine inches in length. The female is not fullyed to the mention.
