The 13th Tex Inf commanded by Col Joseph Bates served most of the war as Coast Guard with Head Quarters at Velasco Tex - in June or July 1863 was ordered to Louisiana and attached to Moutons Brigade Polignys Division After several months returned to Texas and remained at Velasco until the close of the war - was with my Command from time of enlistment until disbanded in May 1865
