Know all men by these presents that we Alejandro Vidal and ~~Victorina~~ Victorina Vidal, Wife of the said Alejandro Vidal, and Gertrudes Estevo Widow of Bartolome Estevo now deceased of the said County of Bexar State of Texas, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred & fifty dollars (\$750.00) as well as for the further consideration of a certain house & lot containing about twelve acres of land, situate in the City of San Antonio, known as the Botin wood grove property, & formerly belonged to Joseph de la Baume dec<sup>d</sup> and purchased by John P. Erskine at Commissioners Sale in 1844. To us in hand paid by Michael Erskine of the County of Bexar State of Texas aforesaid, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, have this day bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Michael Erskine, his heirs successors and Administrators all our right title and interest, both in Law and Equity in and to three leagues of land, being one league and undivided interest in ten leagues, lying and being in the County of Guadalupe on the South West side of the Guadalupe River about twenty miles above the Town of Gonzales, & fifteen miles below the Town of Leguina well known as the Capote tract of land, on which the said Michael Erskine now lives, adjoining on the East or lower part the survey made for one Phineas James, and on the West what is generally called the Davis quarter, being the same which was granted to Joseph de la Baume deceased by the Government of Coahuila and Texas by Antonio Navarro Comissioner by his dec<sup>d</sup>. bearing date the first day of July A.D. 1832 a reference to the said title on file in the General Land Office at Austin will more fully show Two leagues is hereby conveyed by Alejandro Vidal & Victorina his wife daughter of Joseph de la Baume dec<sup>d</sup>: one of which the said Victorina inherited from her father by will, which is of record in the County of Bexar, the other league, the said

Victorino Vidal obtained by purchase or exchange from his Brothers  
Padre de la Baume as will appear by the said Padre de la Baume  
deed dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June 1835 which is this day delivered  
to the said Michael Erskine as further evidence of title - One League  
that is hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed by the said Gertrudes  
Esteve Widow of Bartolome Esteve and daughter of Joseph de la Baume  
deceased she inherited from her Father by his Will which is of Record  
in the said County of Benos To have and to hold the before

described tract or parcel of land (be the same more or less) to the said  
Michael Erskine his heirs Executors and Administrators, together with  
all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in  
any wise appertaining, to him the said Michael Erskine forever

And we the said Alejandro Vidal, and Victorino Vidal  
Wife of the said Alejandro, and Gertrudes Esteve, Widows of  
Bartolome Esteve deceased, for ourselves our heirs Executors  
and Administrators, do covenant with the said Michael  
Erskine, that we will warrant and defend the title to the before  
described land free from the claim or claims of all and  
every person or persons claiming the same, by through  
or under us, but against no other person whatsoever
