Mama is going down now to take some food and Jim going to take care of the children while Annie goes to the funeral.

It is so hot here but cooler than before some rain we had over the weekend - However, Fred Lynn is not accustomed to heat so he is a little fussier and sleeps less than in Salinas - He has some mosquito and chigger bites - which must bother him. He is having a good time tho and is so friendly - Every time I step up to talk to someone he holds his hands out to them - And he is always cutting up and playing.

I stayed with Annie all day yesterday. We did a huge washing.

Nora and children come Sun. took some peaches back. There is a clammer for them all the time. Some is here or calling often. We don't have so many ripe so don't promise anyone if or when they

can have them

We left Salinas Ave - 2:00 PM. of last week and got to Shamrock Fri. morning. ~~Had a flat and had to have a~~ water pump installed - both of which ~~took lots of time~~. Rather took our time though. Fred Lynn was so good on the entire trip - Didn't sleep as he usually does - but fussed very little. There were 2 men, a woman and girl in the car - so when we got tired of his wiggling we put him over with the men. They played with him and he in turn jumped and squealed - to scare them like he does Walden.

Mama and Dad think he is grand and he plays with them - We have Vivian Lee out here while Annie and René are at the funeral. She and Fred Lynn have been asleep nearly 9 hours - It is getting late so will close. Are all well.
