called the Capotis in the said County of Gonsales either
or equitable and do by these presents put him into full
free possession of all my improvements made upon the
same in every manner whatsoever together with the house
and houses. Cribs. Stables. Coupes. &c. &c. and the said
Luskine has the right to use and occupy them for his own
use and benefit and I do further agree and bind myself to
lif^e all enteries which I have heretofore made upon said
Six Leagues of Land which is known as land belonging to the
Estate Jose de la Bruna decd It is understood by the
presents that all matters of title and dispute between me
and the said Luskine has this day been settled and
fully adjusted as to the said Capotis Six Leagues given
unto him and seal this 8th day of July 1815.
