Inf - under Col. ^{L. M.} Hittor Gen Repley's brigade and
served in it till end of war -

was in battle of 1st Manassas under Gen M. G. Evans -
and in following battles in 20 S. C. in the
various engagements around Charleston - bottom
Magyore in Morris Island - Secessionville in
James Island then transferred to Va to
the Valley under Gen Early - in battle of Fisher's
Hill. Cedar Run - before that in battles before
Richmond at Cold Harbor on 29th June 1862 -
then Deep Bottom and Frazer's Farm -
And in many other battles in Lee's army old brigade
in Virginia - and surrendered at Greensboro
North Carolina on 26th April 1865 -
