





WARREN-MILLER CEMETERY

THIS BURIAL GROUND WAS ALREADY SERVING THE PIONEER SETTLEMENT OF RAINEY'S CREEK WHEN THE COMMUNITY'S NAME CHANGED TO CORYELL IN THE EARLY 1870s. MANY OF THE GRAVES HERE ARE NOT IDENTIFIED, BUT THE EARLIEST DOCUMENTED BURIAL IS THAT OF MAY J. WOODY (1825-1871), WIFE OF H.S. WOODY. WHEN WILLIAM MILLER (1796-1875) DIED, 21.5 ACRES OF HIS LAND WERE SOLD TO GEORGE W. MILLER WITH THIS ONE ACRE RESERVED FOR A GRAVEYARD. THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE ESTATE WAS J.B. WARREN AND IT IS SAID THAT THE CEMETERY'S NAME IS THE RESULT OF THIS ASSOCIATION. WARREN-MILLER CEMETERY REMAINS A CHRONICLE OF CORYELL COUNTY'S PIONEERS AND THEIR DESCENDANTS.

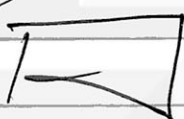
