Humphreys Branch league of land, once owned by A  
Swift and bounded as follows, viz; Beginning at the  
North West corner of the tract of about one hundred  
acres once owned by Wm J Gap, now by J Douglas Brown,  
Thence running with the North line of last mentioned tract  
East five hundred and thirty one varas to a stake; Thence  
North three hundred and nineteen varas; Thence West  
five hundred and thirty one varas; Thence South three  
hundred and nineteen varas to the place of beginning  
containing thirty acres, more or less
