Virginia
Ed Johnson *1st Col* of Regiment - *1st*
Brigadier Gen *H. B. Jackson* of *La.* met
Garnett's troops falling back from Laurel
Hill at Greenbrier River between Alleghany
and Cheat Mountains *1st* under fire at
Greenbrier River. Next winter in winter
quarters on Alleghany Mountain, which
for part of the troops engaged proved to
be war in earnest. Next engagement
at McDowell where the *12th Sept* - many
men killed and wounded. This battle
was the opening of the campaign in '62 when
Stonewall Jackson took command of
the troops in the Valley of Virginia, and
drove Banks across the Potomac, cap-
tured at Front-Royal by the advance of
Shields' command and taken to Fort-
Belvoir and did not join my regiment
until the *1st* Battle of Fredericksburg from
which time participated *with* my regiment in
every engagement up to the surrender at
Appomattox
