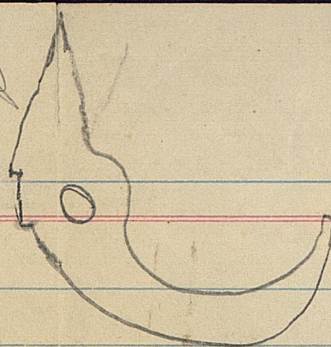

 and extractors. I just emptied
 a case of your carbines and two
 have come back with a shell W.M.C!
 in them, & one blown out. This case
 arrived ~~in~~ my home. June 2, 1884
 and were all sold to Cow Boys.

Now I send you a cut of where
 I would recommend a spring to
 bring home the lever. It can lay
 along side of the Cartidge catch on
 the bottom plate. I would recommend
 a wide nose on end of extractor.
 also, spring a little heavier. The extracting
 part worth all right till its in use
 a week then fails to extract show-
 ing, not quite sufficient extracting
 power. Your cut of Hammerless
 B.L. Gun appears to be a very good
 model. only one thing I could recommend,
 and I recommended it to W.W. Greener
 and will be used by him; is by all
 means double notch the hammer, then
 99 times ~~fit~~ of a 100 in a jar off, its
 caught in safety notch. My experience
 with hammerless for 15 years is I always
 double notch my own guns I am. its
 better than all the safety's ever made,

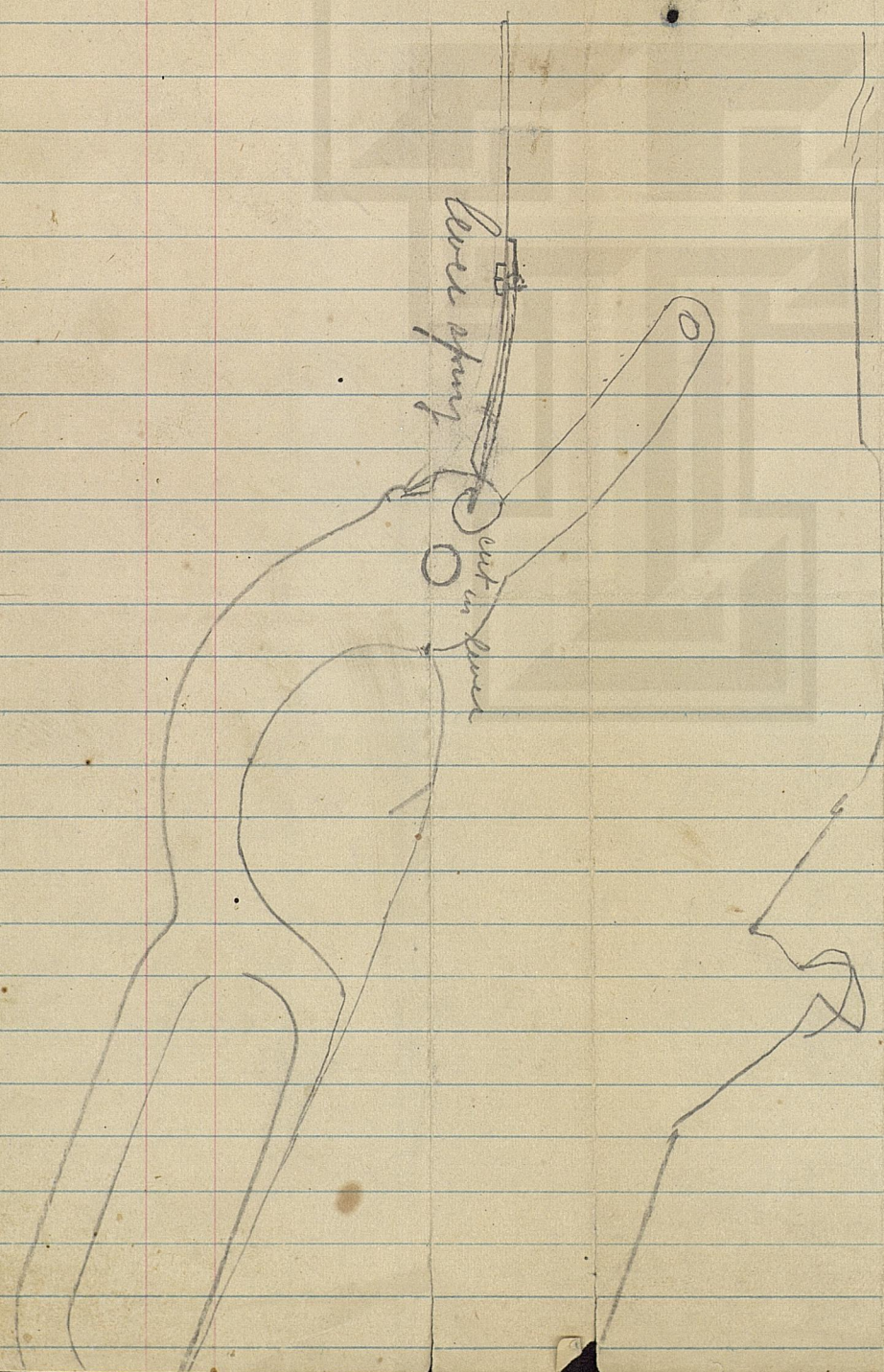
