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TEXAS CONFEDERATE HOME.

REPORT OF BOARD OF MANAGERS.

Austin, Texas, December 1, 1897.

C. A. Culberson, Governor of Texas.

Sir: In transmitting to you the annual report of the Superintendent of the Confederate Home, made to the Board of Managers, we beg to add that the building, now about completed, when furnished, will accommodate thirty-two (32) additional inmates, but the appropriation for maintenance is not sufficient to maintain that additional number for the balance of the fiscal year, ending February 28, 1898, and if that number be now admitted there will necessarily occur a small deficiency, amounting to about one thousand dollars, in the maintenance fund; and to furnish additional room to admit and maintain the whole number, whose applications are now on file and approved (43), there will be a deficiency for the year ending February 28, 1899, amounting to about five thousand dollars. This is without reference to the number of eligible persons who may apply for admission between now and the first of March, 1899. We would respectfully suggest, that if we admit at once, 32, the number for which we have room, it will be necessary for your Excellency to approve a deficiency for the current year for maintenance, of about \$1000, and a building deficiency of about \$2000, in order to supply room for all applicants whose papers have been approved, and eligible ones who may apply before the end of this fiscal year.

Thanking you for your uniform kindness, courtesy and aid to the Board of Managers in its endeavor to secure liberal appropriations for the support of the Home, we respectfully ask that this report be printed.

REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT.

Confederate Home, Austin, Texas, Dec. 1, 1897.

Gen. Henry E. Shelley,

President Board of Managers, Confederate Home.

Sir: In obedience to the law, I herewith submit to you my annual report of the Confederate Home, embracing transactions from December 1, 1896, to December 1, 1897.

Since the last annual report, the number of inmates at the Home has steadily increased, so that we now have one hundred and ninety-seven. The increase, however, has not been equal to the number of applications for admission. The fact that there has been constantly more eligible applicants seeking to be admitted to the benefits of the Home than the crowded condition and want of room would justify the management in receiving has been a source of constant embarrassment. A sympathetic public naturally expects the indigent and helpless Confederate veterans to be promptly taken in charge and cared for at the Home, as the people of the State intended they should be, and which, under the circumstances, it has been impossible to do. For the year beginning December 1, 1896, the average number of inmates per month has been one hundred and ninety-two, and the present number one hundred and ninety-seven, with forty-two approved applications on file, making a total of two hundred and thirty-nine. Our present capacity, counting forty in the hospital, is one hundred and ninety-two. The cottage now in course of construction has a capacity equal to thirty-two, making a total, when every available room is occupied, of two hundred and twenty-four beds. So it seems plain that the same conditions and want of room must continue to exist, at least until another Legislature shall provide for more room, as applications are received almost daily.

The permanent improvements made during the past year are: An entirely new brick kitchen, adjacent to the main dining room, which room has been enlarged by the removal of the partition that separated same from the old kitchen, thus throwing both rooms together and greatly improving the size and convenience of the dining room.

The new kitchen and dining room for the hospital, with rooms in the upper story for cooks and nurses, has been completed and furnished, with very satisfactory results. The cottage, with eight rooms for inmates, is nearing completion and will soon be ready for furnishing.

The present sewerage and sanitary condition of the grounds are excellent.

Permit me again to thank each and every member of the Board for their uniform kindness, co-operation and careful and patient attention

to the best interests of the Home, and to all the officers for their valuable assistance.
