TO: State and Local League Presidents
FROM: The National Office
RE: Revision of Policy regarding mailing of local and state League Bulletins and state Board minutes to National Board members.

It was decided at the National Board meeting in Washington, November 1958, to relieve the state and local Leagues of the burden and cost of sending all their state and local bulletins to all Board members. This will, we hope, come as a decided relief to many local Leagues who have found this an expense and a chore.

Although it was agreed unanimously by the Board that they derive great benefit from the bulletins and broaden their knowledge of the League immeasurably, they feel the load will be lightened if they receive bulletins and other materials from a selected list of state and local Leagues in those states.

The new plan is to apportion certain selected states to each National Board member who will follow the local and state bulletins, state Board minutes and other local and state printed and mimeographed material with interest from the states on her list. We have tried to give a cross-section of states to each Board member, at the same time, attempting to maintain a balance in numbers of local Leagues so that no one Board member will be inundated with bulletins. We have usually included states a Board member has visited recently or expects to visit.

Mrs. Arthur Whittemore has indicated she would like to receive all bulletins from all Leagues in order to keep abreast of what local and state Leagues are doing in the Water Conservation field. Will you please see that Mrs. Whittemore is on your list?

This memo countermands our memorandum of June 1958 in which local League Presidents were requested to send a copy of the local bulletin to each Board member. However, please continue to send two of all local League publications and three of all state publications to the National office. We, in the National office, read them avidly and need them for our permanent files.

The National Board member to whom all your bulletins, printed and mimeographed matter and state Board minutes of your Leagues should be sent from now on will be found listed next to your state.

As a reminder, the National Civic League (formerly known as the National Municipal League) likes to receive bulletins from local and state Leagues. This is their greatest source of information about League of Women Voters activities and as you know, we are often quoted by them. Their address is 47 East 68th Street, New York 21, New York.
