BLEVINS COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL

THE COMMUNITY OF BLEVINS BEGAN ABOUT 1860, WHEN TEXAS REVOLUTION VETERAN THOMAS H. BARRON AND HIS FAMILY SETTLED NEAR DEER CREEK. THE REV. ISAAC TAYLOR OPERATED A SCHOOL FOR AREA CHILDREN FROM THE 1870s UNTIL 1885, WHEN BLEVINS SCHOOL OPENED. A PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT, FORMALLY ORGANIZED IN 1916, SERVED STUDENTS IN A NINE-SQUARE-MILE AREA UNTIL 1939. A POST OFFICE OPERATED FROM 1886 TO 1904, AND AT ITS HEIGHT, THE COMMUNITY BOASTED TWO GENERAL STORES, TWO COTTON GINS, TWO CHURCHES, A BLACKSMITH SHOP, AND AN ICE HOUSE.

BLEVINS CEMETERY

BORN IN THE REPUBLIC OF TEXAS IN 1838, AMANDA RUBLE TAYLOR MOVED TO THIS AREA IN 1855. THIS CEMETERY BEGAN WITH HER BURIAL ON FAMILY LAND IN 1875. HER WIDOWER, THE REV. ISAAC TAYLOR, DEEDED LAND FOR THIS CEMETERY TO THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, SOUTH, IN 1879. THE NUMEROUS INFANT GRAVE SITES REVEAL THE HARSH REALITIES OF FRONTIER LIFE. BURIED ALONGSIDE VETERANS OF CONFLICTS FROM THE TEXAS REVOLUTION TO WORLD WAR II ARE FARMERS WHOSE PERSEVERANCE AND FAITH IN THE LAND HELPED SHAPE THIS AREA. THE BLEVINS CEMETERY ASSOCIATION, FOUNDED IN 1958, RESTORED THIS SITE IN 1991.
