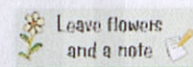

Widow's Application for Confederate Pension

THE STATE OF TEXAS,
County of FREESTONE

I, Mrs. Mamie Sadler do hereby make application to the Comptroller of Public Accounts for a pension, to be granted me under the Act passed by the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Texas, and approved April 7, A. D. 1913, on the following grounds:

I am the widow of A. H. Sadler deceased, who departed this life on the 31st day of May, A. D. 1911, in the county of Dallam in the State of Texas

I have not remarried since the death of my said husband,* and I do solemnly swear that I was never divorced from my said husband, and that I never voluntarily abandoned him during his life, but remained his true, faithful and lawful wife up to the date of his death. I was married to him on the 8th day of April, A. D. 1905, in the county of Taufman in the State of Texas

My husband, the said A. H. Sadler enlisted and served in the military service of the Confederate States during the war between the States of the United States, and that he did not desert the Confederate service. I have been a resident of the State of Texas since prior to January 1, A. D. 1910, and have been continuously since a citizen of the State of Texas. I do further state that I do not receive from any source whatever money or other means of support amounting in value above the sum of \$300.00 per annum, nor do I own in my own right, nor does anyone hold in trust for my benefit or use, estate or property, either real, personal or mixed, either in fee or for life, of the value of one thousand dollars, exclusive of the home of the value of not over \$2000; nor do I receive any aid or pension from any other State, or from the United States, or from any other source, and I do further state that the answers given to the following questions are true:

1. What is your age? and Date of Birth: Age 56 yrs: Born July 29, 1873 *See at 6215 41st Reg*
2. Where were you born? Freestone County, Texas
3. How long have you resided in the State of Texas? since birth
4. How long have you resided in the county of your present residence? about 15 years
5. What is your postoffice address? Teague, Texas
6. Have you applied for a pension under the Confederate pension law and been rejected? No
If rejected, state when and where
7. Did your husband draw a pension? No If so, give his file number
8. What is your husband's full name? Alfred Hulbert Sadler
9. In what State was your husband's command originally organized? Arkansas
10. How long did your husband serve? about 18 months If known to you, give date of enlistment and discharge May 12th, 1862, and was surrendered
11. What was the name or letter of the company, or number of the regiment in which your husband served? If he was transferred from one branch of service to another, give time of transfer, description of command and time of service. (If applicant's husband was a pensioner give his file number, which is evidence sufficient for proof of service.) Company D, 26th Regiment Arkansas Infantry
(Made up of soldiers from Northern part of Texas and Southern Arkansas)
12. Name branch of service in which your husband served, whether infantry, cavalry, artillery, or the navy, or if commissioned as an officer by the President, his rank and line of duty, or if detailed for special service, under the law of conscription, the nature of such service, and time of service. Infantry
enlisted as private, promoted to Corporal July 5th, 1862

13. Do you own any property other than that rendered for taxes in your county? If so, state value of same and county where located. None

14. Have you transferred to another any property of any kind for the purpose of becoming a beneficiary under this law? No

Wherefore your petitioner prays that her application for a pension may be approved and such other proceedings be had in the premises as required by law.

The records show that Alfred H. Sadler, not found as Albert Hubert Sadler, private, Company D, 26th Regiment Arkansas Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted May 12, 1862, at Centreville, Bradley County, Arkansas, for three years or the War. Muster roll for August 12, 1862, shows him promoted to Corporal July 5, 1862. Muster roll for May and June, 1863, shows him present. His name is not borne on the Muster roll for January and February, 1864, only subsequent roll on file.

The records show that D.M. Saddler, also shown as D.M. Sadler, not found as Dupre Sadler, private, Company C, 11th Texas Cavalry, Confederate States Army, enlisted February 25, 1862, at Washington County, Arkansas, Muster roll for January and February, 1864, last roll on file, shows him present. No later record found.

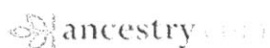

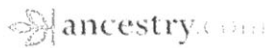

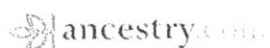
