I belonged to Co "L" Lone Star Rifles. Capt A. C. McKee. 1st Texas Regt. Hood's old brigade. Longstreet's Corps. Lee's army. was wounded and taken prisoner at Sharpsburg Md. Sept 17. 1862. was taken prisoner again at Gettysburg. taken from there to Fort Delaware. I forgot the date of my leaving the prison, but got back to my Company in time for the battles in front of Richmond. was with the Company at the time it surrendered at Appomattox C. H.

The above can be touched for by H. B. McFar and Thomas Blessing, both of this city. My name in the Company was William Haskins.
