I Take pleasure in complying with

The first I knew of Mr Mickle was
when I went to the Army of Virginia
in the fall of 1862. He was then in
the service in Co. K. (I think) 13th Ala
Regt Archers Brigade Hills Liv's
As I remember Archers Brigade were
mostly Tennesseeans. Mr. J. M. Mickle
was a true Confederate soldier and
remained so to the close of the war
we were captured near each other
at Gettysburg on the 1st of July
1863- and imprisoned at Ft. Belvoir
I escaped from there in 1864 ~~but~~
and never saw Mr. Mickle ^{again} until
I met him in Dallas last Spring
He served in the Army of Northern
Virginia. He is worthy all the
honors due a true Confederate
soldier yours very truly
