Was in fight of Wilson Creek Aug 10th 1861
by road near Kansas line in following Sept.
Lexington Mo same month - This was while I
belonged to the State Guards. ~~That winter I~~
The following spring I entered Confederate Service
Co. F. 3rd Mo Cavalry Trans Right + Grant's
Brigade Mansfield's Div. Price's Corps -
First fight in this service at Hartsville Mo
then at Cape Girardeau. Then in many
other battles fighting continually. Then at Helena Ark
4th July 1863. Captured that winter on a
scent and sent to Camp Morton Ind. and
remained in prison until after his surrender.
