I left Greenwood with the first Volunteer army that was organized which was the Physician Rifles went down Red river to New Orleans Parish & layed there until we received orders to go to Virginia they layed at Lynchburg awaiting as sharpshooters arms & when they came they were muskets & some rebelled & would not go I with some of the rest went to Richmond & joined the company of artillery our captain was Sands a young lawyer. Mahone was our General. I was under Meagher in the battle of the Pinnacle until we retreated to Deep Creek from there to Fredricksburg on to Beaters-herge until the Washington artillery got cut up & called for Louisiana & Texas Vol to fill their ranks I was sent to ~~be~~ ²⁶⁰ Washington artillery under Capt Richardson & was in Petersburg at the blow up. I was kept there until Lee surrendered. I was in the seven days fight the blow up of Petersburg. the Pym Pinnacle fight when Lee surrendered we were prisoners at Fort Sumter & taken to point look out Maryland.
