Dear Anna -

I was sorry I could not be with you on Monday ev'g last, but it was late when I got home - & I was too tired to make myself agreeable - and then you know there were so many there, that I preferred to come when I could see you - I was called back several days sooner than I expected, but it was fortunate I came, for poor old Othello had cut his leg & caught cold in it & if I had delayed a few more days, I should have lost him - For James called no surgeon & altho' he did what he could, yet it was a severe case & needed

surgical treatment; but the Dr. says today that he will pull thro' & I'm glad, for altho' he's only an old plug yet I like him & his good for work, too.

I feel awfully homesick today. All my company (4 men) went away yesterday, frightened off by the cold wave — 12° below today — I have used the room so much that I don't care to drive to Blythewood tonight so I must sit & meditate.

I passed Mrs. H. on the road Friday & she gave me a pleasant "Goodmorning," but I haven't seen her since — Strange I should happen to meet Mrs. Eddy again at your house, wasn't it?

Did she say anything about what we were talking of? —

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I wanted to see you again before I left, but altho' it was only a "pleasure trip," yet it was a very busy one & I didn't accomplish half I intended to.

I didn't see you at Steve's wedding but suppose you were there. I saw your bouquets at the house & they were beautiful — Really as handsome as anything there.

I wish you could have been at the reception for we had a very good time.

I have just read over your letter & you say you have a scolding for me — You didn't give it to me when I was there, so I had a narrow escape —

You also say you have something particular to tell me — What

was it? - About the party
we talked of? - I hope you'll
write me soon - for I'm sorry
I didn't see you again -

But I'll try & get to town
again soon - anyhow in time
for the next wedding - Say
Anna, when will it be? -
