AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 9:30 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 148 Present, 5 Absent-excused, 27 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

The Reverend Howard Gates, Manor Baptist Church, Manor, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

Our Heavenly Father, we thank you for our nation and our state. We thank you for democratic processes of government, and for these men and women who act as our representatives. We pray that you will grant them wisdom, insight, and moral courage as they work on our constitution. Give special wisdom to President Daniel and others who lead in this task.

Father, we pray for our beloved nation, and we ask that you will direct our President and our national leaders. Give us peace in the Middle East, and prosperity and justice at home.

Now, Lord, we pray for ourselves as individuals. Guide us in our difficulties, forgive us of our mistakes and sins, and enable us to seek not the good, but the best. Teach us dependence upon you. We dedicate this day to you.

Thank you for hearing our prayers. In Jesus' name. Amen.

ARTICLE V ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article V.

Question: Shall Article V as amended be adopted?

Delegate Hudson explained Section 16 of Article V.

Delegate Hudson offered the following amendment to Section 16 of Article V:

Amend Section 16(b), Article V, to read as follows:

(b) Appeal to the supreme court in criminal cases shall be at the discretion of the court, unless otherwise provided by law.

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Nabers explained Section 17.

Delegate Heatly explained Section 18.

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Bynum who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced Present."

LEAVES OF ABSENCE

Delegate Semos was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Cates.

Delegate Leland was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Johnson.

Delegate Hilliard was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Sherman of Tarrant.

Delegate Lee was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of illness on motion of Delegate Hoestenbach.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Hall of Harris, Schwartz, McAlister, Allred, Whitmire and Cobb who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Baker offered the following amendment to Section 18 of Article V:

Amend Section 18, District Attorneys; County Attorneys Section (a) Line 19, by inserting the word "basic" between the words "the" and "Compensation".

The amendment was read.

Delegate Sullivant moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 20 Yeas, 124 Nays, 3 Present-Not Voting, 33 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

Delegate Sanchez (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Sutton (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment, the amendment was adopted by a non-record vote.

VOTE RECORDED

Delegate Hoestebach requested to be recorded as voting Present-Not Voting on the adoption of the Baker amendment.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Doggett, Gammage, Lary, Lewis, Temple, Bryant and Hernandez who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Adams of Jasper who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Vecchio was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Garcia.

Delegate Lombardino was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Weddington.

Delegate Atwell was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of illness on motion of Delegate Heatly.

Delegate Powers explained Section 19 of Article V.

(Delegate Jones of Harris in Chair)

Delegate Sullivant offered the following amendment to Section 19 of Article V:

Amend Section 19 of Article V by striking the word "basic".

The amendment was read.

Delegate Washington moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 89 Yeas, 54 Nays, 3 Present-Not Voting, 34 Not Voting. (Record 3, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Montoya (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Sutton (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Peveto explained Section 20 of Article V.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Uher and Wyatt who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Mauzy offered the following amendment to Article V:

Amend Article V by adding a new section to read as follows:

Section ____ GENERAL CHARGE; WRONGFUL DEATH; DIRECT ACTION. (a) In all actions for damages the court shall submit the issue to the jury in a general charge, which shall read either, "We find for the plaintiff in the amount of ____ dollars" or "We find for the defendant".

(b) In litigation involving the wrongful death of a minor child, mental pain and anguish suffered by a parent of the child as a result of the child's death shall be considered in determining the amount of damages to be awarded.

(c) In civil litigation in which an insurance company is a real party in interest, the injured party shall have a right of direct action against the insurance company and suit may be brought against the insured alone or against the insured and the insurer jointly, at the option of the injured party.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Caldwell moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 89 Yeas, 52 Nays, 5 Present-Not Voting, 34 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Ragsdale who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Delegate Washington offered the following amendment to Section 1 of Article V:

Amend Article V, Section 1, to read as follows:

Section 1. JUDICIAL POWER. The judicial power of the state is vested in the judicial branch. The state judicial system is composed of a supreme court of civil appeals, a supreme court of criminal appeals, the intermediate courts of civil appeals, intermediate courts of criminal appeals, district courts, and circuit courts.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Powers raised a Point of Order against further consideration of the amendment, as it was substantially the same as one previously defeated by the Convention.

The President sustained the Point of Order.

Delegate Washington offered the following amendment to Section 1 of Article

Amend Article V, Section 1, to read as follows:

Section 1. JUDICIAL POWER. The judicial power of the state is vested in the judicial branch.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Hale moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 85 Yeas, 58 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 35 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Boone (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Sutton (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Question: Shall Article V as amended be adopted?

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article V.

Question: Shall Article V as amended be adopted?

Delegate Denson offered the following amendment to Section 5 of Article V:

Amend Article V, Section 5, by eliminating Section 5 and substituting the following:

The legislature may establish by law circuit courts with one or more judges.

The amendment was read.

(Delegate Powers in Chair)

Delegate Baker moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 59 Yeas, 78 Nays, 4 Present-Not Voting, 39 Not Voting. (Record 6, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Boone (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Sutton (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment, shall the amendment be adopted?

Delegate Hale offered the following substitute for the amendment to Section 5 of Article V:

Amend Article V, Section 5 to read as follows:

Section 5. CIRCUIT COURTS. The legislature shall provide by law for circuit courts. A circuit court may serve one or more counties, but no county shall have more than one circuit court. Each circuit court shall have one or more judges and such other officials as provided by law.

The substitute for the amendment was read.

Question recurring on the adoption of the substitute for the amendment, the substitute was adopted by the following vote: 77 Yeas, 61 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 40 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

The amendment as substituted was then adopted by the following vote: 76 Yeas, 60 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 42 Not Voting. (Record 9, Appendix)

Delegate Andujar was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Adams of Jasper.

Delegate Willis offered the following amendment to Section 7 of Article V:

Amend Article V, Section 7, Subsection (b), to read as follows:

(b) The county commission in each county shall establish and maintain one or more justice courts in the county with each court to exercise jurisdiction in one or more precincts in the manner provided by law; provided, however, the county commission in each county with a population of more than 100,000 according to the last preceding federal census shall establish and maintain four or more justice courts in the county.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Spurlock moved to table the

amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegate Adams of Hardin who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Evans who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Delegate Washington offered the following amendment to Section 9 of Article V:

Amend Article V, Section 9(e) to read as follows:

(e) Municipal judges are elected by the qualified voters of their respective municipal corporations every four years in the manner provided by law.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Kaster moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

Delegate Hoestenbach offered the following amendment to Section 11 of Article V:

Amend Article V, Section 11(3) by deleting it in its entirety and substitute the following:

(3) The legislature may create a judicial council having such membership as provided by law which shall prescribe rules of administration for the unified judicial system and perform such other duties as shall be provided by law.

The amendment was read.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 65 Yeas, 62 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 51 Not Voting.

Delegate Hoestenbach requested a verification of Record 10. The verification was ordered and reflected the following: 64 Yeas, 62 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 52 Not Voting.

By unanimous consent verification of "nays" was dispensed with.

There being 64 Yeas, 62 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 52 Not Voting, the motion to table prevailed. (Record 10, Appendix)

Delegate Lary offered the following amendment to Section 11 of Article V:

Amend Article V, Section 11 by adding the following new subsection:

(4) Notwithstanding any of the other provisions of Section 11 of this article the legislature by general law may prescribe rules of administration for the unified Judicial system.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Grant moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 44 Yeas, 91 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 44 Not Voting. (Record 11, Appendix)

(Delegate Murray in Chair)

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment, the amendment was adopted by the following vote: 86 Yeas, 56 Nays, 0 Present-Not Voting, 38 Not Voting. (Record 12, Appendix)

Question: Shall Article V as amended be adopted?

amendment to Section 15 of Article V:

Amend Article V, Section 15 by deleting the entire Section, and renumbering all the following Sections accordingly.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Calhoun raised the Point of Order against further consideration of the amendment as it was substantially the same as one that had been previously defeated.

The President sustained the Point of Order.

Question: Shall Article V as amended be adopted?

The motion to take recess was lost by

the following vote: 48 Yeas, 82 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 49 Not Voting. (Record 15, Appendix)

Question next on the motion to take recess until 2:00 o'clock p.m. on Monday.

The motion to take recess prevailed by the following vote: 68 Yeas, 63 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 48 Not Voting.

Delegate Adams of Jasper requested a verification of Record 16.

Delegate Hale moved to dispense with the verification.

The motion to dispense with the verification was lost (not receiving two-thirds vote of the Members of the Convention) by the following vote: 72 Yeas, 54 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 53 Not Voting. (Record 17, Appendix)

The verification was ordered and reflected the following: 66 Yeas.

By unanimous consent verification of the "Nays" was dispensed with.

The verification reflected the following: 66 Yeas, 63 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 50 Not Voting. (Record 16, Appendix)

Accordingly, the Convention at 5:20 o'clock p.m. took recess until 2:00 o'clock p.m. on Monday, May 20.
