
Alexandria, VA Samuel Kunkel served 4 1/2 years in the Civil War and then went to Old Mexico where he stayed 2 years. Came back to the US where he drove a Stage for 6 years in Arkansas; married, and farmed for 8 years until his health became bad. He then sold the farm and moved to a place he called "Middle", Texas in 1879. This was 125 miles west of Ft. Worth. He lived there 26 years before selling out and moving to the North Panhandle in 1905. In a letter he wrote to his cousin, Sam Konkel, in Springfield, Colorado on 22 July 1915 he says, - "We expect to go back to Middle, Texas the last of next month, to the Old Settlers' reunion. Sam you should spell your name KUNKEL instead of KONKEL, for KUNKEL is correct. Lovingly your cousin, Sam Kunkel."
