Know all men by these presents that I, Ireland Hampton of Tarrant County, Texas, for a valuable consideration to me paid, receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby bargain, grant, sell and convey unto Pamela Dorcas Miller of Tucker County, West Virginia, for her separate use and benefit, an undivided one half interest in and to that certain tract of land situated in Scurry County, Texas, being One hundred, fifty seven and seven tenths (157.7) acres, abstract number 133, Cert. number 37/1748, Survey No. 95, H. & T.C.Ry. Co., original grantee, being the Northwest one quarter of said section.

This conveyance is subject to an encumbrance of \$2000.00 of which \$1000.00 matures in 1913, \$1000.00 1914. This conveyance is also with the understanding that upon sale of said land, if it net sufficient money, Ireland Hampton shall be reimbursed for certain sums now aggregating \$1320.30, which he has paid out on account of said land, and with the understanding that he shall also be reimbursed such other sums as he may hereafter pay. All such payments shall bear interest from date at 6%.
