JAMES G. FERGUSON DIES IN BELTON

Belton, June 7.—James G. Ferguson for many years a resident of Belton died tonight at 7 o'clock at his home in south Belton. The deceased was 82 years of age and fought throughout the civil war. He was born in Arkansas in the year 1837 and moved to Texas many years ago with his family.

The funeral services will be conducted tomorrow afternoon at 4 o'clock at the residence on South Pearl street by Rev. P. E. Riley, pastor of the First Methodist church of this city. Interment will be in the Three Forks cemetery southeast of this city.
