CSA Service J J MCADAMS physical description

John James McAdams and his brother, William Joseph McAdams, joined the 23rd Tn Inf Co D (Martins Regt) at Wartrace Tn. This co later became 3rd 4th Tn Cav Co D (McLemores). John James was captured by the Yankees and escaped. He survived 13 wounds and was covered with scars on his body. The last time he was wounded was when he was trying to escape his second capture while he was imprisoned in Illinois. He was paroled at the time of surrender and later drew his army pension. This company escorted Jefferson Davis on his retreat and final capture in Ga. It is believed by some historians that the Confederate gold was divided among the rebel troops and that subsequently that the majority of them were robbed of this money by the Union soldiers.

Physical description of John James McAdams taken from his Civil War records: florid complexion, dark hair, blue eyes, 5'8-1/4" height. Born 1844, son of Alexander D and Nancy A Nelson McAdams

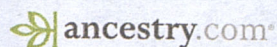

Civil War Service

In November 1861, William Joseph, his elder brother John James and his uncle John Watkins Nelson joined Company D of a regiment of partisan rangers(militia) being raised by Col George Dibrell, the 8th Tennessee Cavalry Battalion. James W. Starnes was elected commander. In May 1862, the 8th was reorganized and designated the 4th Tennessee Cavalry Regiment, called Starnes' 4th until Starnes' death on June 30, 1863 in action against Rosecran's advance on Chattanooga, thereafter called McLemore's 4th after Major W.S. McLemore, who succeeded Starnes as commander.

Starnes' Fourth Tennessee Cavalry was one of the seasoned regiments composing Gen. Nathan Bedford Forrest's "Old Brigade". Forrest's hometown was Chapel Hill in Marshall County, nearby John and William's hometown of Belfast. William's wife, Mary Frances King grew up in Chapel Hill.

CONFEDERATE TENNESSEE TROOPS

4th Regiment, Tennessee Cavalry (McLemore's)

OVERVIEW: 4th (Stanes'-McLemore's) Cavalry Regiment, originally called 3rd Regiment, completed its organization at Camp Robertson, Bledsoe County, Tennessee, in May, 1862. The men were from the counties of Wilson, Marshall, Bedford, Rutherford, Smith, Marion, Coffee, and Franklin. The unit was formed by adding four companies to Stanes' 8th Cavalry Battalion. It was assigned to Forrest's, Humes', Biffle's, T. Harrison's, and Dibrell's Brigade. The 4th skirmished in Kentucky, moved to West Tennessee and saw action at [Parker's Cross Roads](#), fought at [Franklin](#) and [Chickamauga](#), then took part in the [Atlanta Campaign](#). Later it split: part was active in East Tennessee and Virginia and rejoined General Wheeler at Savannah; the other part served with General Forrest in Middle Tennessee and Mississippi. The regiment was reunited in South Carolina during January, 1865, and went on to participate in the campaign of the Carolinas. It was included in the surrender on April 26. The field officers were Colonels William S. McLemore and James W. Stanes, Lieutenant Colonel Peril C. Haynes, and Major Peter T. Rankin.

Predecessor unit:

8th Cavalry Battalion was organized at Camp Cheatham, Robertson County, Tennessee, in December, 1861, with six companies. The unit served in the Department of East Tennessee and skirmished at Readyville. During May, 1862, it merged into Stanes' 4th Tennessee Cavalry Regiment. Its commanders were Lieutenant Colonel James W. Stanes and Major Ewing A. Wilson.
