(Tuesday, June 4, 1974)

AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 9:30 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 152 Present, 6 Absent-excused, 23 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

The Reverend Bobby L. Eklund, Pastor, First Baptist Church, Hurst, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

Heavenly Father,
We give you thanks for every good and perfect gift. Especially today are we grateful for the fact you put it into the minds and hearts of our forefathers to give to us a government that is for the people and by the people. We want to thank you for men like these who give of their time and energies and intelligence in order that we can have a better government. We ask that today you give to them the special wisdom they need in order to take care of the business of our state government properly. We ask all of this in Jesus' Name. Amen.

LEAVES OF ABSENCE

Delegate Creighton was granted leave of absence for today on account of important state business on motion of Delegate Blanchard.

Delegate Moore was granted leave of absence for today on account of illness on motion of Delegate McKnight.

Delegate Heatly was granted leave of absence for today on account of compassionate reasons on motion of Delegate Tarbox.

Delegate Laney was granted leave of absence for today on account of inclement weather on motion of Delegate Adams of Jasper.

Delegate Whitmire was granted leave of absence for today on account of compassionate reasons on motion of Delegate Adams of Hardin.

Delegate Nugent was granted leave of absence for today on account of death in family on motion of Delegate Davis.

ARTICLE X ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Section 9 of Article X, with a Minority Report pending.

Question: Shall the Minority Report be adopted?

Delegate Green of Harris explained the Minority Report.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Sherman of Tarrant, Garcia, Hall of Harris, Hernandez, Poff and Cooke who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

LEAVES OF ABSENCE

Delegate Mauzy was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Mattox.

Delegate Semos was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of illness in family on motion of Delegate Cates.

Delegate Donaldson was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Kaster.

Delegate Johnson was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of illness on motion of Delegate Reyes.

Delegate Meier moved to table the Minority Report.

The motion to table the Minority Report was lost by the following vote: 21 Yeas, 123 Nays, 2 Present-Not-Voting, 35 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Henderson (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Heatly (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Question recurring on the adoption of the Minority Report, shall the Minority Report be adopted?

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegate Jones of El Paso who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Delegate Nugent who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Grant offered the following amendment to the Minority Report:

Amend Minority Report by adding on line 8, page 2 after the word "used" the following language:

"by the owner".

The amendment to the Minority Report was read.

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The amendment failed of adoption by a non-record vote.

(Delegate Doyle in Chair)

Delegate Caldwell offered the following amendment to the Minority Report:

Amend the Minority Report on Section 9, Article X, as follows:

— Insert the phrase "insurance and" on line 3 after the comma and before the word "taxes".

The amendment to the Minority Report was read.

(President in Chair)

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Head who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Sanchez was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of illness on motion of Delegate Atwell.

Delegate Green of Harris moved to table the amendment to the Minority Report.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 123 Yeas, 19 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 37 Not Voting. (Record 3, Appendix)

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Washington who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present."

Delegate Ogg offered the following amendment to the Minority Report:

Amend the Minority Report for Article X, Section 9 of the majority proposal by inserting the following language beginning after the word "homestead" at the end of line 7. "Nothing in this section shall prohibit any person from refinancing the original mortgage on his homestead, the spouse, if any, joining therein, so long as the fair market value of the homestead in question be valued in excess of \$20,000, nor shall any protections provided by this section be waived thereby, as provided by law."

The amendment to the Minority Report was read.

Delegate Green of Harris moved to table the amendment to the Minority Report.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 108 Yeas, 26 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 46 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

The Minority Report was then adopted by the following vote: 125 Yeas, 16 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 37 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Cobb (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Heatly (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Question on the adoption of Section 9 as amended, Section 9 as amended was adopted by the following vote: 133 Yeas, 12 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 35 Not Voting. (Record 6, Appendix)

Delegate Green of Harris explained Section 10 of Article X.

Section 10 was adopted by the following vote: 138 Yeas, 1 Nay, 1 Present-Not Voting, 41 Not Voting. (Record 7, Appendix)

RECESS

On motion of Delegate Green of Harris the Convention at 12:00 o'clock m. took recess until 1:30 o'clock p.m. today.

AFTER RECESS

The President called the Convention to order at 1:30 o'clock p.m., pursuant to recess.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegate Whitmire who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegates Ragsdale, Simmons and Bales who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

LEAVES OF ABSENCE

Delegate Lary was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of death in family on motion of Delegate Doggett.

Delegate Clower was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Braecklein.

ARTICLE X ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article X.

Delegate Sage explained Section 11 of Article X.

Delegate Bailey offered the following amendment to Section 11 of Article X:

Amend Article X, Section 11 by deleting the current language and substituting therefor the following:

Section 11. WAGES NOT SUBJECT TO GARNISHMENT EXCEPT FOR CHILD SUPPORT. No current wages for personal service may be subject to garnishment, except that the legislature may provide for the garnishment of not more than 20 percent of a person's wages to enforce court-ordered child support in any case where such person is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be in contempt of the order to pay such support.

Delegate Sage moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 80 Yeas, 67 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 33 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

Amend Section 11 of Article X, the General Provisions Committee Report, by striking the period at the end of the section and adding the following:

"", except that the legislature may provide for the garnishment of not more than 25 percent of a person's wages to enforce court-ordered child support, in any case in which the person has disobeyed a child support order."

The amendment was read.

(President in Chair)

Delegate Wieting moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 98 Yeas, 52 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 30 Not Voting. (Record 9, Appendix)

Question on the adoption of Section 11, Section 11 was adopted by the following vote: 119 Yeas, 30 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 30 Not Voting. (Record 10, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Simmons (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Heatly (absent), who would vote "Yea".

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegate Bowers who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Rodriguez who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Reynolds explained Section 12 of Article X.

Section 12 was adopted by the following vote: 148 Yeas, 3 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 29 Not Voting. (Record 11, Appendix)

Delegate Sage explained Section 13 of Article X.

REASONS FOR VOTE

Due to bank stock holdings, I am voting "Present" on all votes on Section 13.

TEMPLE

Any vote on Section 13 will be a conflict of interest because of my stock interest in a bank and a bank holding company. (Present-Not Voting on all votes on this section)

CLAYTON

(Delegate Caldwell in Chair)

Delegate Gammage offered the following amendment to Section 13 of Article X:

Amend Article X, Section 13 by adding after the word "place" the following language:
"in Texas".

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Kaster offered the following amendment to Section 13 of Article X:

Amend General Provisions Committee Report on Article X by striking Section 13 in its entirety and renumbering the subsequent sections accordingly.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Sage moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 127 Yeas, 15 Nays, 6 Present-Not Voting, 33 Not Voting. (Record 12, Appendix)

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Delegate Calhoun, pursuant to Rule IX, Section 2, requested to be recorded as Present-Not Voting on Record Vote 12.

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Wilson offered the following amendment to Section 13, Article X:

Amend Subsection (b) of Section 13, Article X, by striking all of Subsection (b) and substituting the following:

(b) No holding company shall acquire control of any lending institution by merger, purchase, or otherwise when the effect of such acquisition will result in such holding company having more than 8% of the total domestic funds on deposit in the State of Texas.

The amendment was read.

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Sage moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 81 Yeas, 74 Nays, 6 Present-Not Voting, 20 Not Voting. (Record 13, Appendix)
